COAST CAMPAIGN Unfinished Symph (Aloha Prospector), winner of Saturday's GII Shoemaker H., came out of the race in "perfect" condition according to trainer Wesley Ward; he will ship to New York next week for an East Coast campaign. Ward said the four-year-old would make his next start in the GIII Daryl's Joy H. at Saratoga July 24, then point for the Belmont Budweiser Breeders' Cup September 2 and the Kelso H. October 7 before another try at the Breeders' Cup Mile October 28. The colt was third in the race last year. "The whole schedule is subject to change, of course," said Ward. "The main thing is, we want to get the horse acclimated for the Breeders' Cup. If all goes well, he'll already have had two races over the course."

The attendance was up 16 percent from last year's opener. On-track handle for the first day of the '95 season was \$570,371; total handle was \$850,625.

HANDLE UP AT PIMLICO SPRING MEET Bolstered by a record-setting Preakness, the total handle for the 1995 Pimlico Spring Meet was up 13.9 percent over last year's figure. The handle, which includes all in-state and out-of-state wagers, totalled \$145,058,333 for the 49-day meeting which ended yesterday; last year, the total handle was \$127,350,539 for the 56day meet. The average daily in-state handle also improved 13.9 percent, from \$1,820,469 in '94 to \$2,073,579 this year.
