TALKIN MAN TO UNDERGO SURGERY Talkin

Man (With Approval), who returned to the racetrack just nine days ago after a post-Triple Crown break, is again out of training and will undergo surgery to remove a fractured splint bone in his right front leg. Trainer Roger Attfield said that the colt would be sent to Dr. Robert McMartin's clinic for surgery Tuesday. "It's not major surgery, but it'll be at least six weeks before he can return to even light training." Attfield added that he has been aware of the problem since the Preakness. "We've been watching it closely," he said. "It's bothering him by irritating the suspensories on that leg. If it happened to split further, it could really cause damage by rubbing against the suspensory ligaments. It's best that we take it out." Talkin Man had been pointing for the Queen's Plate; tentative plans call for him to aim for the September 17 GI Molson Export Million at Woodbine.

DEVIL HIS DUE OUT OF BROOKLYN Devil His Due (Devil's Bag) was scratched from yesterday's Brooklyn H. after trainer Allen Jerkens discovered filling in the six-year-old's right front leg. "It might be something serious; we don't know," said Jerkens. "We'll try to get him to Saratoga and see what happens."

SANDPIT TO CAESARS Sandpit (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}) is scheduled to arrive in New Jersey Wednesday afternoon to prepare for a start in next Sunday's GI \$500,000 Caesars International. A champion in Brazil and a 2xGISW since shipping to the U.S. in 1994, he was most recently second in the Hollywood Turf H. Joining him on the flight will be Celtic Arms (Fr) (Comrade in Arms {GB}) a 2xGI winner in France who has vet to find the winner's circle in the U.S. Opera Score (Nureyev), winner of the Miramontes H. at Santa Anita this spring, may also make the trip. Drawn by the Caesars East-West Challenge, the Californians will attempt to capture the Caesars and return home for the \$250,000a Caesars Palace Turf Championship at Hollywood July 22. A winner of both races would receive a bonus bringing his total earnings in the Challenge to \$750,000. Expected Eastern-based runners include The Vid (World Appeal), a three-length winner of the Early Times Dixie in his last start, and Alice Springs (Val de l'Orne {Fr}), a five-year-old mare with a win over the course in last year's Matchmaker H.; she brings a threerace winning streak into the event.

Bouncing back from back-to-back off the board finishes in the Santa Anita and Illinois Derbies, Petionville teamed up with jockey Pat Day for the first time and rallied from midfield to take command at the eighth pole, then had enough left to hold off Dazzling Falls in the photo, "I had some anxious moments to the wire," said Day. "My horse lost momentum--he was jumping shadows and, guite frankly, I wasn't too sure we got there first. I was more than a bit pleased when they made it official. He ran a great race to be able to overcome his late antics." Trainer Randy Bradshaw said the colt would be pointed for the Swaps S. at Hollywood July 23. The 6-5 favorite OLIVER'S TWIST (Horatius) shadowed pacesetter I STILL BELIEVE (Believe It) for three-quarters but stopped abruptly and was eased. "He had good position down the backstretch but he bobbled at the half-mile pole," said his rider, Alberto Delgado. "I don't know if he stepped in a hole, or what. But he wasn't responding; he just stopped running at the threeeighths pole." Thistledown track veterinarian Dr. Kent Vasco said that a preliminary examination indicated the colt had injured his right stifle, but that the injury did not appear to be career-threatening.
