# MOONAX FACES SIX IN GOLD CUP Moonax

(Caerleon), winner of St. Legers in both England and France last autumn, will face a maximum of six opponents when he bids for his third Group 1 prize in Thursday's Gold Cup over two and a half miles at Royal Ascot. The colt returned from a winter spent in Dubai to score an impressive victory in the Yorkshire Cup. "I'm sure he is a better, stronger horse than he was last season and his style of racing is the sort that suggests he will stay the extra distance of the Ascot race," said trainer Barry Hills. France, looking for it's first Gold Cup win since Sagace (Fr) (Luthier {Fr}) in 1977, will be represented by The Little Thief (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}). Bred by the late Paul de Moussac, he will try to win beyond two miles for the first time. Other possibles are Admiral's Well (Sadler's Wells), Double Trigger (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}), Old Rouvel (Riverman), The Flying Phantom (Sharrood) and Vintage Crop (Rousillon).

# CALDER FULL-CARD EXPERIMENT A "GO"

Calder Race Course is ready to move ahead with its plan for an experimental period of full-card simulcasting. The six-day trial will begin Sunday, June 25; Calder handicappers will be able to wager directly into the host track's pools, at the host track's takeout levels. The original plan would have employed net pool pricing, which would have added the 3 percent simulcast fee charged by host tracks to Calder's takeout.
