NEW YORK SHOWCASE TO BE A MILLION

DOLLAR DAY The New York Thoroughbred Breeders

Inc. (NYTB), New York Racing Association (NYRA) and the New York State Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund have announced a joint agreement to raise the total amount of purses for the stakes races carded for the second edition of "The New York Showcase" -the all New York-bred card to be run at Belmont Park Saturday, October 14--to \$1,000,000. This would be an increase of \$450,000 over the purses for the successful inaugural held last fall when each of the following stakes was worth \$75,000. The new schedule of races and purses for "Showcase Day" is headed by the \$250,000 Empire Classic, for ages three and up at 1 1/8-miles. Both the Mohawk H. (ages three and up, 1 1/16-miles turf) and the Ticonderoga H. (three and up, fillies and mares, 1 1/16-miles turf) will carry purses of \$150,000. The six-furlong Hudson H. for ages three and up and the seven furlong Iroquois H. for fillies and mares ages three and up will be worth \$125,000. And the Sleepy Hollow for two-year-olds and the Maid of the

It was a one-horse race from the beginning, with Double Trigger, third in last year's St. Leger, setting all the pace and finding more "gas in the tank" whenever it was required. He broke quickly and set a good gallop. At the halfway stage, the French-trained THE LITTLE THIEF (Ela-Mana-Mou (Ire)) was pulled up, but did not appear to suffer any life-threatening injuries. With six furlongs left to go, Double Trigger was challenged by Moonax and, coming with a game run the veteran VIN-TAGE CROP (GB) (Rousillon), bidding to be the first eight-year-old winner of the race since 1900. However, Double Trigger lengthened his stride to deny the favorite Moonax victory and give trainer Mark Johnston his first winner at Royal Ascot. "Everything seemed to be going wrong this week," said Johnston. "I was beginning to think there must be an Ascot jinx on my horses. But there is no better race to break your duck at the Royal meeting than the Gold Cup." Johnston added that Australia's Melbourne Cup may be next for Double Trigger.

BANDERA DOWNS IS SUBJECT OF

INVESTIGATION Business practices at Bandera Downs, which closed suddenly Tuesday, may lead to a criminal investigation, the San Antonio Express-News reported vesterday. The Texas Racing Commission's Executive Secretary Dave Freeman said a commission audit found over \$400,000 missing from a state-mandated purse account, and added that the track is facing another \$500,000 in unpaid bills from other creditors. Bandera Downs officials said they are working closely with the Texas Racing Commission and the H.B.P.A to effect the closing of the racetrack, and added that they are eager to accommodate the investigators and are providing whatever information or records are requested. The track's owners emphasized that they are making every effort to satisfy creditors and horsemen as quickly as possible. Bandera Downs is for sale for \$4.5 million, including the license and fully operational facility, free from debt and/or encumbrances.

SWAPS FIELD TAKES SHAPE Arkansas Derby winner Dazzling Falls (Taylor's Falls), Jersey Derby winner Da Hoss (Gone West), Gll Hollywood Juvenile Championship winner Mr Purple (Deputy Minister), Gll Del Mar Futurity winner On Target (Forty Niner), undefeated Shinnecock Hills (Skywalker) and To Be Khaled (Libanon) were all late nominations to the \$500,000 Swaps S., to be run at Hollywood Park July 23. The late nominations were made at a cost of \$2,000 each. Leading candidates already pointed to the GII Swaps are Kentucky Derby and Belmont S. winner Thunder Gulch (Gulch) and Ohio and Louisiana Derby winner Petionville (Seeking the Gold). Other possible runners include recent allowance winners Geri (Theatrical {Ire}) and T.J.'s Gold (Candi's Gold), as well as Louisiana Derby runner-up In Character (GB) (Never So Bold {Ire}). As for the supplements, trainer Ron McAnally plans to run both Mr Purple and On Target in the July 2 Affirmed S. before making a decision on the Swaps, while owner Donald Kroeger and trainer Chuck Turco are seriously considering shipping Dazzling Falls to California for the race. "I think we've got a pretty good shot of getting Dazzling Falls," said Hollywood's Racing Secretary Martin Panza. "I think the owner is weighing his options, and I know the trainer would like to get another shot at Petionville." In last Saturday's Ohio Derby, Petionville held off a late charge from Dazzling Falls to win by a head.
