### LONG BRANCH STAKES NEXT FOR TIMBER

COUNTRY? Preakness winner Timber Country (Woodman), forced to miss the Belmont S. after he developed a fever, may make his next start in the Long Branch S. at Monmouth Park July 8. "We're leaning towards running him in the Long Branch," said Todd Pletcher, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "We are pointing him towards the Haskell, and running him in the Long Branch accomplishes several things. First of all, he needs a race...and then, it will be a race over the track." Pletcher, who added that the Dwyer S. at Belmont would be the alternative for the Eclipse winner, said Timber Country appears to be completely recovered from his brief illness. "He lost about five days of training, but now he's training smoothly. He's been breezing real good."

### **CHRB ESTABLISHES INTEGRITY OF RACING**

**PROGRAM** The California Horse Racing Board Friday approved several rules and policies which will fully implement its Integrity of Racing Program, designed to protect the welfare of all racing participants through a variety of programs to bolster security, improve drug testing, standardize penalties and sanction the use of therapeutic medications. A rule approved yesterday which acknowledges levels for specific therapeutic medications deemed necessary for the maintenance of the health and welfare of the horse is the first of its kind for any U.S. racing jurisdiction. The Board also updated the classification of drugs and established penalty guidelines corresponding to the new classifications. These approvals bring the Integrity of Racing Program to full force; other aspects of the program, including the establishment of continuing education for stewards and investigators, had already been started.
