DEL MAR DENNIS TUNES UP FOR GOLD CUP Del Mar Dennis (Dixieland Band) worked five furlongs in 1:00 2/5, handily, over the fast main track at Hollywood Saturday as he gets ready for next Sunday's Gl Hollywood Gold Cup. "I'm really happy with the way he's training for this race," said conditioner Paco Gonzalez, who added that the gelding galloped out the six furlongs in 1:13 3/5. "He's very good right now. He's as good as he's ever been." Campaigning for leniency from the racing secretary, Gonzalez remarked, "The only thing that worries me is the distance. He's not really a mile-and-a-quarter horse. A mile and an eighth is more his distance; if he gets stuck with too much weight, I'm not sure what we'll do." The five-year-old finished fourth under 118 pounds in the GI Hollywood Turf H. May 29. The Hollywood Gold Cup will be televised live on ESPN; post time is set for 3:40 p.m. PDT.

SEBASTIAN OUT OF IRISH DERBY Sebastian (Sadler's Wells), forced to miss the Epsom Derby after pulling a muscle, has also been counted out of the Irish equivalent next Sunday. A 10-length winner of his Derby prep, the colt has not yet recovered from his setback and will be out of action until later in the season. "Sebastian is improving, but we feel the Irish Derby will come too quickly for him," said trainer Henry Cecil. "We don't have any specific targets, but we hope it won't be too long before he's ready to return."

RETAMA STICKS TO SCHEDULE Retama Park announced Friday that it will continue to offer live Thoroughbred racing through September 17, its original closing day. Officials at the San Antonio track had discussed ending the season two weeks early. "After further evaluation, we have decided to contniue with our original schedule," said Retama President Bob Quigley. "It is better for our horsemen, patrons and overall operations to keep with our original plan."
