FLORIDA HORSEMEN FILE SUIT The Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association filed suit in U.S. District Court in Miami June 26 against 75 racetracks and casinos for taking the simulcast signal from Hialeah during the last 10 days of the meet. The FHBPA contends the defendants owe horsemen over \$1 million in purse money, based on over \$11 million wagered on the signal. Invoking the 1978 Interstate Horse Racing Act, FHBPA President Kent Sterling said, "The lawsuit will define the contractual rights of horsemen's organizations to agree to, or withdraw consent for simulcast wagering." The suit is believed to be the first filed seeking enforcement of an existing contract with horsemen, who contend Hialeah breached its contract with the FHBPA by underpaying purses through the track's 60-day meet. "Those outlets being sued chose to ignore our attorney's letter advising them that we had withdrawn our consent to accept wagering on simulcasts," said Sterling. Operations as big as New York OTB and the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority, and as small as Champs Grill and Tap, can expect to receive registered letters this week informina them of the pending litigation. Spared from the lawsuit were the New York Racing Association and the Kentucky ISW outlets, who did not take the Hialeah signal.

#### ELLIS PARK OPENS TODAY Ellis Park in

Henderson, Kentucky, opens its gates for the 1995 summer season today. The track, which runs Tuesday through Sunday with first post at 3:00 p.m. weekdays and 1:00 p.m. weekends and holidays, will feature an 18-race stakes schedule worth more than \$1.4 million. The highlight of the 61-day meet is the GIII \$200,000 Gardenia S. for fillies and mares at nine furlongs, to be run August 20. "This season's stakes schedule will be the most lucrative ever offered at Ellis Park," said Racing Secretary Tim Day. The track will be open through Labor Day, Monday, September 4.

HOLLYWOOD GOLD CUP-GI, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, 10f CONCERN AND CIGAR TO CLASH

It was confirmed Monday that Cigar (Palace Music), 126, and Concern (Broad Brush), 123, will face off for the winner's share of the \$1 million purse. Cigar, who had been scheduled for a short vacation, will arrive at Hollywood Saturday morning; rival Concern will ship in Saturday night. The two have met twice before. Cigar carried 120 pounds to victory in the GI Oaklawn H. April 15 with Concern six-and-a-half lengths back in third under 122; Cigar was once again the winner under 122 pounds in the Pimlico Special, while Concern checked in third, beaten five lengths, under 121. Both colts own wins over the Hollywood dirt. Cigar broke his maiden going six furlongs over the strip May 9, 1993; Concern showed his fondness for the surface more recently, scoring an impressive two-and-three-quarter length win in the GI Californian.

#### **BEST PAL PREPS**

Racing's leading active money earner, **Best Pal** (Habitony), had his final major prep for the Gold Cup yesterday, going six furlongs in 1:12 3/5 over the fast main track at Hollywood. Regular rider Chris McCarron was aboard for the breeze. "He went extremely well," said McCarron. "It was a very good work. I expect him to run an improved race in the Gold Cup." The seven-year-old gelding finished fourth in the Californian last time out.

**BEVERLY HILLS H.-GI**, \$300,000, 3yo/up, f/m, 9fT **Fondly Remembered** (Skywalker), an allowance winner over the course two starts back but off the board in both the GI Gamely H. and GII Wilshire H. at the current meet, will face five tough rivals in Sunday's co-feature at Hollywood. The five-year-old, second in last year's GI Yellow Ribbon, breezed six furlongs in 1:12 4/5 on the main track yesterday; she will carry lightweight of 112.

Also expected are: MGISW Possibly Perfect (Northern Baby), highweight at 124, a perfect three-for-three in '95; 11xSW Work The Crowd (Political Ambition); MGISW Wandesta (GB) (Nashwan); last year's Yellow Ribbon winner Aube Indienne (Fr) (Bluebird); and Lady Affirmed (Affirmed), second in the GI Gamely H. in her only start this year. Possible are Alpride (Ire) (Alzao), a MGSW-Italy; and GISP Morgana (El Gran Senor).
