"He worked really well and then, just past the wire, when the exercise rider Ron Tanner went to stand up on him, he just fell face-first to the ground," said trainer Ben Perkins, Jr., who added that the five-year-old was sent to New Bolton for an autopsy. "There's no sign of a heart attack, but he did fracture his neck when he fell," said Perkins. "The pathologist feels it may have been a neurological reaction in his brain, but so far the autopsy results have proven inconclusive." Tanner suffered a broken collarbone in the spill.

TIMBER COUNTRY ON LASIX? Preakness winner Timber Country (Woodman), who arrived at Monmouth Park Thursday morning to get ready for the GI Haskell Invitational July 30, bled in a workout at Belmont Park June 19 and may race on Lasix in his next start. "We are not too concerned about it," said Dallas Stewart, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "If he needs to run on Lasix, that's what we'll do. And now we almost have Lasix in New York, so it's not a problem. He's doing great." The colt's connections are still on the fence about a start in the Long Branch S. "Our main goal is the Haskell," said Stewart.
