CIGAR GLOWS IN GOLD CUP VICTORY

Proving that a change in plans and a coast-to-coast charter could not put out his fire, Cigar (Palace Music) shipped in for Sunday's GI \$1,000,000 Hollywood Gold Cup and left the field in a cloud of smoke. With jockey Jerry Bailey sitting chilly, the five-year-old sat fourth on the rail through the early fractions, eased out for running room on the backstretch, dragged his rider to the lead as they headed around the far turn and won as he wished by 3 1/2 lengths as the odds-on favorite. "He was as tough as they come today," said Bailey. "He settled very well behind horses, but midway down the backside he wanted to put them away. I really didn't want to go, but he's bigger than I am so I let him do what he wanted. He's just the best horse I've ever been on." The second choice in the wagering, Concern (Broad Brush), who had shown more early foot than usual when winning the Californian, was once again far back early, making up some ground but hanging in the drive to finish fifth. Explained jockey Mike Smith, "When the doors opened, he hit his head and I think he knocked out a few teeth. He was shaking his head for the first quarter-mile--I think it rang his bell pretty good. By the time he did level off, they were long gone. You can't give up that kind of ground and make it up against those horses. They're too good." Winning trainer Bill Mott did not say where his champion would head next in quest of a 10th straight victory. "We changed our plans to come out here, so before I open my mouth again we need to map out a campaign for the year's end that will get him to the Breeders' Cup in good shape," said Mott. "We'll give him all the time he needs to recharge his batteries, and then we'll go again." Hollywood Gold Cup chart p2. News cont. p2

A dramatic last stride win for the French Derby third Winged Love, who gave trainer Andre Fabre his first major Derby victory. DARAYDAN (Kahyasi {Ire}), pacemaker for the 6-5 favorite CELTIC SWING (Damister). set the fractions for seven furlongs, when MUNWAR (Kalaglow {Ire}) took over and led to the top of the stretch. But when they straightened for home, the frontrunners gave way and it was Definite Article in the middle of the track and Winged Love running up the rail in a battle to the wire. The Irish hope Definite Article looked to have the race won until the last jump, but Winged Love kept finding more and he snatched the race on the line to give Sheikh Mohammed his second Irish Derby win. The Sheikh's Old Vic took the race in 1989, and the filly Balanchine, running for his Godolphin Racing, was the winner last year. "This win was very special," said Sheikh Mohammed. "Winged Love is an improving horse and he should be even better at the end of the season, when he will go for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe." The winning owner donated all his prize money from the race to the St. Vincent de Paul Hospice and other local charities. Celtic Swing loomed boldly on the far turn but failed to fire and trailed in a well-beaten eighth. "This run was too bad to be true," said his owner, Peter Savill. "We cannot make any plan for him now. We'll take him home and get the vets to check him over."

FLORIDA'S FULL-CARD SIMULCASTING ON

HOLD In a letter dated June 29, Deborah Miller, Director of the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, warned Pompano Park harness track to stop full-card simulcasting. Pompano offers full-cards on racing from the Meadowlands and Yonkers Raceway. Citing a Florida law which states that a track can offer only two simulcast races for every eight live races run, Miller wrote, "...until such time as the legislature has the opportunity to review the simulcast issue further, I intend to enforce the 20 percent level imposed by law. Pompano Park, and any other pari-mutuel permitholder, is expected to comply..." Calder is one of the "other permitholders." The recent Calder full-card experiment has generated \$40,800 in taxes for the state and \$100,700 in purses and breeders' awards. A provision in the 20 percent law allows the Division director to grant special permission to simulcast more races if a track can show that full-card simulcasting will increase purses. Both Pompano and Calder have met the requirement, but Miller has decided to forego the nearly \$1.4 million in tax money Calder alone could generate between now and when the legislation is back in session in March, 1996.
