CIGAR'S OPTIONS OPEN The day after Cigar's (Palace Music) impressive victory in the Hollywood Gold Cup, trainer Bill Mott had roughed out a partial plan for the five-year-old's fall campaign while remaining uncertain as to what his next start would be. "I would like to run him in the Woodward (Sept. 16) and then in the Breeders' Cup Classic (Oct. 28)," said Mott. "What's in between (now and the Woodward), I'm not sure. I'll maybe back off a bit--not take him out of training, but miss a race rather than run him back in 30 days." Mott had originally planned to run in the August 5 Whitney at Saratoga, before the decision to run at Hollywood was made. Now, said the trainer, "we're just going to kind of sit and wait." Cigar is scheduled to fly back to New York this afternoon.

GOLD CUP GENERATES RECORD HANDLE Sunday's total Hollywood Park handle of \$16,138,816-an increase of 50.3 percent from 1994--was a record for a Hollywood Gold Cup program and the third-highest in Hollywood history. The previous Gold Cup record of \$12,025,141 was set in 1993. Sunday's on-track attendance of 27,003, up 54.3 percent from last year, was the highest since 1991.

HOLLYWOOD GOLD CUP WRAP-UP Runner-up Tinners Way (Secretariat), third-place Tossofthecoin (Magesterial) and fourth finisher Blumin Affair (Dynaformer) will all point for the \$1 million Pacific Classic August 13 at Del Mar. Best Pal (Habitony), fifth in the Gold Cup, came out of the race with a sore left front foot. "It's probably a bruise or a little abscess; it was noticeable when he walked this morning," said trainer Richard Mandella Monday. Concern (Broad Brush), who finished off the board for the first time since 1993 running sixth, suffered a loose tooth and some superficial scrapes on his left flank, but otherwise came out of the race in good order and will ship back to Laurel this evening. Del Mar Dennis (Dixieland Band). who pressed the pace but weakened and ended up seventh, bled in the race. "We'll freshen him up for Del Mar, but we're not sure when he'll race," said trainer Paco Gonzalez. Urgent Request (Ire) (Rainbow Quest), a distant eighth after cutting out the early fractions, will likely make his next start on grass. "Maybe he's not a dirt horse after all," remarked conditioner Rodney Rash.
