NYRA MULLING SIX-DAY RACE WEEK AT **BELMONT FALL MEETING** New York Racing Association officials are considering a return to a sixday race week this fall when racing returns to Belmont Park Sept. 1, according to NYRA President Kenny Noe. "Some of the horsemen were talking to Terry (Director of Racing Terry Meyocks) and myself and felt that some of their horses have been set back," said Noe. "If we feel that there are enough horses and it is important for the horsemen to have a chance to run more often, we may go back to a nine-races-a-day, six-days-a-week schedule. We don't want to have short fields, but if we feel there are enough horses available, we may do this. I'm not saving the decision has been made, but we might take a look at it." Noe said if the decision were made, the likely dark day would be Monday.

WEKIVA SPRINGS TO NEW YORK Wekiva

Springs (Runaway Groom), who capped off a six-race winning streak with a victory in the GII San Fernando S. at Santa Anita in January, has been jogging at Donald Dizney's Double Diamond Farm in Florida and will be sent to trainer Bill Mott shortly for a fall campaign in New York, with the Oct. 28 Breeders' Cup the ultimate goal, trainer Bob Hess Jr. reported Tuesday. "Mr. Dizney (who owns the four-year-old gray along with Jim English) and I talked it over and decided it was best to go that route," said Hess, who had trained Wekiva Springs at his Southern California base. "He's a bad shipper and we felt it was best to keep him in New York to prepare for the Breeders' Cup (at Belmont). After the Breeders' Cup, the plan is to have him come back to the West Coast." Wekiva Springs, who has won six of nine career starts for earnings of \$389,135, has been sidelined with a minor ailment to his right front foot since early May. He last raced in the sevenfurlong Commonwealth Breeders' Cup at Keeneland April 14, in which he finished fifth.
