DUBAI TO STAGE WORLD'S RICHEST RACE

Dubai will be the stage for the world's most valuable horse race next year. The Emirates Racing Association has announced the inauguration of a new intercontinental race, called the Dubai World Cup, which will have its first running Wednesday, March 27, 1996 at Nad al Sheba racecourse in Dubai. The race for four-year-olds and up at 11/4-miles on sand will carry a total purse of \$4 million U.S. dollars, with \$2.4 million going to the winner. Entry is by nomination of \$5,000 U.S. dollars this October 9, 1995, or \$10,000 January 2, 1996, with a starting fee of \$30,000 Sunday, March 24, making the maximum cost to run \$40,000 or one percent of the purse. Nominations will be taken from Dubai, Europe, the Americas, Oceania and Asia to present a field of 14 runners. The selection of runners and reserves will be made by an international panel of senior handicappers and racing secretaries. Runners and reserves will be announced by mid-January 1996 to allow those connections that wish to train in Dubai for one month before the event to take advantage of Dubai's weather and state-of-the-art training and technical facilities. Speaking in Paris yesterday, Louis Romanet, Director of International and EEC Relations at GIE-GALOP, said, "This is terrific news. It is what the world has been waiting for, and will be of great encouragement for International Racing." The race is scheduled to be run at 7 p.m. Dubai time, and both it and supporting events will be sponsored.

Mandella said **Best Pal** (Habitony)'s foot "is a lot better" since the all-time leading active money winner's fifth-place finish in Sunday's Hollywood Gold Cup. "Right now, he's barefoot," said Mandella. "There are no plans for him at this time. We'll see how things go."
