CELTIC SWING OUT FOR THE YEAR

Celtic Swing (GB) (Damister) will not race again in 1995. The winner of this year's French Derby, unbeaten as a juvenile, suffered an injury when finishing a disappointing eighth in last Sunday's Budweiser Irish Derby. Owner Peter Savill said yesterday, "The horse has severe concussion to the bones of his left knee. There are no fractures, but there is evidence of torn ligaments off the bone of the same knee. We have decided to retire him for 1995 in order to give him every chance of a full recovery as a four-year-old." Celtic Swing was rated Europe's top two-year-old after winning the Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster last autumn. He made a successful reappearance in Newbury's Greenham S., but then lost his perfect record when narrowly beaten by Pennekamp in the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket.

HALL OF FAMER NEVES DEAD AT 74 Hall of Fame jockey Ralph Neves, known as the "Portugese Pepper Pot" for his fiery personality, died Thursday night after a battle with lung cancer. Neves, inducted into the Hall of Fame in 1960, finished his 30-year riding career in 1964 with 3,771 wins, which made him one of the top 10 jockeys of all time at that time.

VIRGINIA RAPIDS TO JONABELL IN '96 Virginia Rapids (Riverman), a GISW of \$566,015, has been retired and will stand the 1996 season at Jonabell Farm in Lexington. Purchased by Jonabell and longtime associate J. Mack Robinson, the five-year-old made his final start June 9 at Belmont Park, finishing off the board in the GIII Jaipur S. A graded stakes winner at three and four, he was runner-up in the GIII Toboggan H. at Belmont two starts back. Virginia Rapids will stand as property of a partnership for \$6,000, live foal.

Red Bishop (Silver Hawk), a stakes winner on three continents, goes for his fourth straight. The Kentucky-bred ended his '94 campaign with a win in the Hong Kong International Vase and is two-for-two in '95 with victories in Hong Kong's Queen Elizabeth 2nd Cup and Santa Anita's GI San Juan Capistrano. The seven-year-old is also a 3xSW and 5xGSP in England. Three-year-old filly **Tryphosa** (Be My Guest) takes on older males after finishing third, beaten a length, in the Prix de Diane. The Irish-bred, winner of the German 1000 Guineas, has been on the board in all seven career starts.

Trainer Angel Cordero Jr. saddles **Rogues Walk** (Ends Well); the New York-bred scored an impressive victory in the GII Reeve Schley S. at Monmouth last out, but Cordero is realistic about his chances of beating the favorite. "To be honest, I don't think my filly can beat **Serena's Song** (Rahy), but every horse gets beat some time," he said. "I never thought Secretariat would lose and he did. DISTANT VIEW TO KENTUCKY **Distant View** (Mr. Prospector), rated Britain's top three-year-old miler last season, has been retired to stand at stud in the U.S. The colt established his reputation with a win in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood last July, but an injury suffered this spring has ended his racing career. He will take up stallion duties for 1996 at owner Khalid Abdullah's Juddmonte Farm in Kentucky. "He was a very good horse," said his trainer, Henry Cecil. "Unfortunately, he strained a suspensory tendon just below the knee and we had to give up any hope of getting him back."
