## "SERENA" SETTLES FOR SECOND IN

COACHING CLUB Golden Bri (Gold Alert). runner-up in the GI Mother Goose a month ago, handed 1-5 Serena's Song (Rahy) her first defeat in distaff company since the '94 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, following the favorite to the top of the lane before unleashing a stretch drive that carried her to a 1 1/2-length victory in yesterday's Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont Park, "Going into the race, I thought I would be happy with second," said winning trainer John Kimmel. "Serena's Song looked better today than she did going into the Mother Goose. But I thought, with the further distance, we would have a better chance of beating her--anything over a mile and an eighth is probably stretching Serena's Song's capacity." But trainer D. Wayne Lukas refused to use the distance of the race as an excuse. "We just got beat today," he said. "I don't think it was the mile and a quarter, and I can't blame the heat and humidity. The fractions were all right; she just didn't kick. I could see it in the stretch. She was in position to win, but she just didn't fire this time." Her jockey, Gary Stevens, was more inclined to take the route into account. "The mile and a quarter is a little suspect for her," said the rider. "A mile and a sixteenth or a mile and an eighth today and she would have gotten the job done. She really tried; she dug down deep but she just didn't have it. When she came back, she was corded up--vou could see the ripples down her spine. That's the sign of a tired horse." The Team Lukas champ will have the chance to take on Golden Bri at 10 furlongs once again at Saratoga; the fillies are scheduled to meet for the rubber match in the GI Alabama August 12. The starters for this race had already won over \$3.9 million between them, MUHTARRAM (Alleged) and ELTISH (Cox's Ridge) were the ante-post favourites, but it was the classy Halling, unbeaten in his last five starts, who set the pace under jockey Walter Swinburn and outfinished the late-closing Singspiel for the victory. "We could see that there was not going to be much pace, so we decided to make all the running," said Swinburn, "Halling relaxes in front and is very willing-once I asked him to go on I really felt something special. He just took off." Muhtarram ran a disappointing sixth and came out of the race lame, with a suspected fractured off-fore pastern. ENVIRONMENT FRIEND (Cozzene), winner of this race in 1991 and making his fourth appearance in the event, finished a creditable fourth: he combines stud duties with a career on the racetrack. The German hope TRYPHOSA (Be My Guest) was not helped when held up in the paddock before the race by a problem with her saddle.
