"REGAL" REVENGE IN QUEEN'S PLATE

After guiding All Firmed Up to a game nose victory in the Plate Trial, jockey Todd Kabel probably thought he'd have a tough decision to make. Woodbine's leading rider had also piloted the promising Freedom Fleet to miss by the same margin in the Marine S.; which colt would he ride in an attempt to win his first Queen's Plate? As it turned out, the decision was made for him. Kabel found himself without a Queen's Plate mount as late as last weekend after owner Frank Stronach opted to ship in Shane Sellers for his Plate Trial winner and New Yorker Mike Smith for his Marine S. second. But the mount on Regal Discovery (Regal Classic) came open after regular rider Dave Penna was injured in a spill last Monday, and the 9-1 shot gave Kabel a measure of revenge as he rallied past favored Freedom Fleet (Afleet) in the final furlong to take yesterday's 136th running of the Queen's Plate at Woodbine by a length and a quarter. Following the instructions of trainer Roger Attfield, Kabel settled his mount in midpack to the top of the stretch, then shot through an opening on the rail and ran down the runner-up to win going away. "I knew, having ridden Freedom Fleet, that he had a tendency to pull himself up once he got to the lead--and that's just what happened," said Kabel. "This is so sweet--every Canadian rider dreams of winning this race." Attfield had saddled the winners of two of the last three runnings of the event--Alvdeed in '92 and Peteski in '93--but looked in trouble for '95 after his talented Talkin Man was sidelined with a fractured splint bone. But the trainer was not surprised by the second-string victory. "I said as far back as the spring meet at Keeneland that this horse had a chance to win the Queen's Plate," he said. "He was slow coming around, that's all." A record Queen's Plate handle of \$1,014,057 was generated at Woodbine and off-track betting shops in the Toronto area; more than \$7 million was wagered on the complete card.

Regal Discovery, whose lone previous win had come against maidens at Woodbine last September, improved off a troubled fourth-place finish in the Plate Trial to post a rallying triumph over Freedom Fleet, part of the favored three-horse Frank Stronach entry. Rated in seventh for a quarter, the bay moved steadily through the pack to engage Freedom Fleet in midstretch, then prevailed in the drive; he raced with blinkers off for the second time and Lasix on for the first time after bleeding in the Plate Trial. The place horse, Freedom Fleet, closed from well back early to take a clear lead but could not hold off the winner. "When he made the lead, he got to looking around," said his rider, Mike Smith. "If I could have ridden it over, maybe I would have tried to stay back a little longer, but he was taking me to the leaders effortlessly--l just tried to stay out of his way." Stronach runner ALL FIRMED UP (Affirmed), the winner of the Plate Trial, pressed the pace for a mile and weakened to be fifth; his stablemate, the usually speedy filly HONKY TONK TUNE (Cure the Blues), was slow early and showed little, finishing 11th.

Arlington International Racecourse's closest competitior for the gambling dollar has become the Illinois riverboat casino revenue leader. The Grand Victoria, which is docked 12 miles from the track and hit the water in October, raked in \$15.8 million in adjusted gross receipts in June, more than any riverboat in the state. According to Paul O'Connor, who is spearheading Arlington owner Dick Duchossois' legislative drive for a racing-industry riverboat, the success of the Grand Victoria comes as no surprise. "Number one, they are the biggest, and number two, they are in the juiciest part of the demographic tenderloin," said O'Connor. Duchossois is convinced that the riverboat casino is having a major negative impact on his meeting, which began June 23, but said that the extent of the damage won't be known until the meet ends September 4.
