"Maybe he's just not a dirt horse," said Rash. "The day he won the Big 'Cap, it was a sealed track they listed as wet/fast. Now, if he doesn't run well in this race on the turf, maybe we'll turn him out for a while and reevaluate. But he's training good and he seems to be fine, so we figure it's worth a shot." The Caesars Palace Turf Championship will be televised live on ESPN; scheduled post time is 2:10 p.m. PDT.

ENGLISH JOCKEY CLUB INVESTIGATES

BETTING COUP According to a report from the Australian Associated Press printed in today's Daily Racing Form, English trainer David Nicholls will have to go before the Jockey Club after sending out the surprising and surprisingly well-bet Samah to win at Newmarket Wednesday. The victory was reputed to be worth more than \$2.2 million to the horse's backers. Samah had been offered at as much as 20-1 early in the day, but was sent off the 7-2 favorite in Wednesday's H & K Commissions H. after finishing off the board in his four previous starts; he had won the race last year for owner Stuart Aitken, who raised evebrows when he pushed \$120,000 through the windows on his '95 Santa Anita H. victor Urgent Request. Aitken no longer owns Samah, but he was rumored to have bet \$30,000 on his one-time colorbearer, who just managed to win the race by a short head. Nicholls was called before the stewards to explain his charge's form reversal, but the Newmarket officials have referred the case to the Jockey Club for further investigation.
