"The Haskell is the start of the second season for these horses, and they usually come in rested and in top form. Timber Country is on the grounds training for the race. Pyramid Peak (Mt. Livermore) (120) won the Long Branch...and trainer John Ward has indicated that he will return for the Haskell. Suave Prospect (Fortunate Prospect) (120) was second in the same race, and (trainer) Nick Zito said he is definitely coming back. Rick Violette has Citadeed (Shadeed) (118)--he said he's training well and is being pointed toward the Haskell." Expected highweight Timber Country missed a scheduled work yesterday due to the extreme heat, but he is expected to breeze this morning.
