SOUTHERN TRUCE KILLED BY LIGHTNING

Southern Truce (Truce Maker), the rags-to-riches mare who came up through the claiming ranks to win two Grade I stakes and \$867,578, was killed by lightning in Kentucky earlier this month. The seven-year-old, claimed for \$16,000 in March of 1991 by Vic and Peggy Johnson's Regal Rose Stable, was sold to Robert and Janice McNair of Texas for a reported \$300,000 last year; she ran her last race May 10, finishing fourth in a Churchill allowance, and was in foal to Seattle Slew at the time of her death.

MR PURPLE PREPS FOR SWAPS Mr Purple (Deputy Minister), winner of the GIII Affirmed H. last out, worked six furlongs in 1:14 2/5 at Hollywood Sunday as he gets ready for his next engagement in the \$500,000 Swaps S. next Sunday. The colt is three-forthree over the Hollywood main track; he will face Kentucky Derby and Belmont Stakes winner **Thunder Gulch** (Gulch), Ohio and Louisiana Derby winner **Petionville** (Seeking the Gold), and Alabama, Arkansas and Remington Park Derby winner **Dazzling Falls** (Taylor's Falls) in the Swaps.

PIMLICO ANNOUNCES SUMMER STAKES

SCHEDULE The GIII Polynesian and GIII Columbia Stakes will headline the \$1,085,000, 16-race stakes schedule at Pimlico this summer. Pimlico opens for the 42-day meet Tuesday, July 25; it will be closed briefly during the Timonium State Fair, August 26 through September 4, then re-opens September 7 through closing day, October 1. The \$100,000 Polynesian, for three-year-olds and up at a mile and a sixteenth, will be run September 9, and the \$100,000 Columbia, a sixfurlong test for three-year-old fillies, is set for September 23. Pimlico will also offer an overnight stakes schedule worth \$160,000 during the meet.




