SANDPIT HITS CAESARS JACKPOT Sand-

pit (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}) proved up to the East-West Challenge yesterday, earning the \$312,500 bonus put up by Caesars World with his 1 3/4-length win in Hollywood Park's 12-furlong GII Caesars Palace Turf Championship. The winner of the June 25 GI Caesars International at Atlantic City handed his trainer a difficult choice after that win--to stay on track toward the August 27 mile-and-a-quarter Arlington Million, or to aim for the bonus that would be his for victory in the mile-and-half leg of the Caesars double--and be forced to shorten up down the road. "The bonus is very valuable here," admitted trainer Dick Mandella. "One of the main objectives was, and is now, the Arlington Million. The best preparation for the Million a month away is probably not a mile-and-a-half race, but this guy's so big and strong and he's so happy around the barn, he gets over his races quick. So I don't think there will be a problem going back to a mile-and-a-quarter." Looking at Sandpit's long-term plans, Mandella said a return to the Japan Cup, where he was fifth last year, might be in order. "The Breeders' Cup is a tough question, because he's not eligible, his sire's not eligible, so it makes it a big ticket to get in," said Mandella. "The Japan Cup is very attractive because there are no fees at all, expenses are paid and it's a big purse. But right now, we won't worry about that. We'll worry about the Arlington Million." (Caesars Palace chart, p2)

HASKELL FIELD TAKES SHAPE A field of seven or eight now seems likely for next Sunday's GI \$500,000 Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park. Heading the list of probables for the race is Serena's Song (Rahy), who beat the boys in the Jim Beam S. at Turfway in March. Also expected are the first three finishers from the Long Branch S., Pyramid Peak (Mt. Livermore), Suave Prospect (Fortunate Prospect) and Mighty Magee (Cormorant); Kingdom City (Cryptoclearance), winner of the Round Table S. at Arlington; Blue Grass winner Wild Syn (Wild Again); and Peter Pan victor Citadeed (Shadeed). The filly is scheduled to breeze at Monmouth early in the week. "She's doing great," said Dallas Stewart, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "We're looking to work her Monday or Tuesday."

All eves were on Derby hero Lammtarra, bidding to maintain his unbeaten record in only his third lifetime start and the subject of controversy prior to the race when his owner decided to replace regular rider Walter Swinburn with Lanfranco Dettori. BROADWAY FLYER (Theatrical {Ire}) led at the start, picking up the pace with a half mile to go as Lammtarra made progress behind him. But with two furlongs left, it was Pentire snatching the lead and looking a winner until Lammtarra came between horses with a magnificent late run. Enthused winning rider Dettori, "Lammtarra must be a champion. I was nudged out on the home turn, so we had to run wide to keep our balance, and when Pentire came to hit the front I never thought we could beat him. But Lammtarra kept finding a bit more all the way to the line. He has so much heart--it must take up 90 percent of his body." Said Sheikh Mohammed, the uncle of the 19-year-old owner, "The plan is to give him a rest, and then maybe head for the Arc de Triomphe and possibly the Breeders' Cup." Last year's Arc winner, CARNEGIE (IRE) (Sadlers Wells), was a disappointing runner, making no impression at all on the race.
