TIMBER COUNTRY BACK ON WORK TAB

Timber Country (Woodman) breezed a half-mile in :47 3/5 at Monmouth Park yesterday morning, galloping out five furlongs in 1:00, but his connections declined to speculate where the Preakness winner would make his next start. "The big horse worked beautiful," said Dallas Stewart, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I've never seen him work that good before. He went in :47 3/5 and the track wasn't that fast this morning. I think we may have a nice fall with him. We'll just get him ready and when he's ready, that's when we'll run him. We're going to wait on him to tell us he's ready." Stewart said that Serena's Song (Rahy), who will become the first female starter in the Haskell since 1971, will work this morning for the July 30 GI event.

FABRE DUBIOUS ABOUT PENNEKAMP'S

RETURN Pennekamp (Bering {GB}), idle since sustaining an injury in the Epsom Derby, now looks unlikely to make it back to the races. Trainer Andre Fabre admitted this weekend that he was "dubious" about the three-year-old's future at the track. Pennekamp was rated second among European juveniles last season after winning the Dewhurst S. at Newmarket; he returned to that course this May to defeat Celtic Swing (GB) (Damister) in a stirring battle for the 2000 Guineas. The colt started 11-8 favourite for the Derby but suffered a hairline fracture to his right front fetlock joint and could manage no better than 11th of 15 behind Lammtarra. "Pennekamp is resting and Sheikh Mohammed has still to make a decision whether to bring him back or retire him to stud," said Fabre.

BALANCHINE TO ARC Balanchine (Storm Bird), withdrawn from Saturday's King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. because of the firm ground at Ascot, will now be prepared for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October. Last season's European champion three-year-old was disappointing in her reappearance in Royal Ascot's Prince of Wales's S., but Simon Crisford, racing manager to her Godolphin owners, has scotched rumours that Balanchine is to be retired. "She goes for the Arc and runs in the Prix Foy beforehand," said Crisford yesterday. Meanwhile, Broadway Flyer (Theatrical {Ire}), who led Saturday's King George field into the straight but faded to finish fifth, will take a break before racing again and will be pointed to either the Irish St. Leger or the Grosser Preis von Baden this fall.
