"We will consider the Jerome; it is a one-turn mile which is not ideal, but it's not a bad coming-out party," said Lukas.

BREEDERS' CUP TO CALIFORNIA IN 1997 According to a report in today's *Daily Racing Form*, the 1997 Breeders' Cup will be held at a track in southern California, although the exact site of the event has not yet been decided. Officials at Santa Anita, Hollywood and Del Mar are all interested in playing host in '97. D. G. Van Clief, executive director of the Breeders' Cup. told the *Form*, "We've received preliminary information and proposals from all three tracks, which we're assessing." A final decision will not be made before September.

SERENA'S SONG READY TO FLY AT

MONMOUTH Serena's Song, the only wheel chair-accessible hot-air balloon in the country, will be at Monmouth Park today as part of its nation-wide tour, offering rides to disabled children from 7-9 a.m. and 7-9 p.m. The balloon, owned by Gary and Cheryl Waldman, is named for their daughter Serena, who has cerebral palsy; this will mark the first time that the balloon and the horse of the same name will be in the same location. Although it is just a coincidence that their star filly shares her name with another flying machine, horse owners Robert and Beverly Lewis help sponsor the balloon flights.
