SERENA SINGS AGAIN "We came. We made history." If trainer D. Wayne Lukas has a way of getting right to the point, his filly Serena's Song (Rahy) fits right in with his philosophy. With a decisive, frontrunning 3/4-length victory over 10 colts, she became the first filly ever to win the \$500,000 Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park yesterday. "It's exciting for us, and it's exciting for her to make history," said Lukas, who picked up his first Haskell win as well. "It was never an issue with us (about her running in this race), but if it was an issue with anyone else, she answered with a resounding 'yes.'" The win was Serena's Song's second of the year against colts. A win in the Jim Beam Stakes sent her into this May's Kentucky Derby as the favorite alongside stablemate Timber Country (Woodman); she finished 16th in the Run for the Roses after setting the early pace. While many thought she would be rested following the effort, Serena's Song instead came back 13 days later to win Pimlico's GII Black-Eved Susan. She added another win in Belmont's GI Mother Goose before finishing second in the GI Coaching Club American Oaks in her last start. Her 1995 record now stands at 7-for-9. "She doesn't like a couch-potato attitude," said Lukas. "She thrives on the action. She wants to get out there every day and train." Owner Robert Lewis expressed a happiness with not only his filly, but his trainer and jockey as well. "When you have a team working for you like D. Wayne Lukas and Gary Stevens, you're really blessed," said Lewis. "We fully appreciate how great this filly really is." Lukas said Serena's Song will not face colts again this year, but will make one more start at Belmont Park this fall against her own sex (possibly in the Sept. 16 Ruffian) before the Oct. 28 Breeders' Cup Distaff. Runner-up Pyramid Peak (Mt. Livermore) and third-place finisher Citadeed (Shadeed) will most likely be pointed to the Aug. 19 \$750,000 Travers at Saratoga, according to their connections. Said Citadeed's trainer, Rick Violette, "Wayne won't be running the filly in there, will he?"

Jockey Gary Stevens sent Serena's Song after the leaders into the first turn. The pair took over down the backstretch and opened up a quick 3½ lengths on the field as they turned for home. "I told Gary if she was running easy, go ahead and open up a couple of lengths," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I thought if we could get the first 3/4 in 1:10 2/5, we'd be right there. I told Gary if you get that fraction, go ahead and open up. We want to dictate the race. We want to be in control of our own destiny. If she could do that, I thought it would be catch me if you can." No one could. "She put a move on them at the 1/4-pole that was just unbelievable," said Stevens. "She's something very special."




