HENNESSY PREPS FOR SAPLING Trainer D. Wayne Lukas was on hand at Monmouth yesterday, keeping a watchful eye on the final Sapling preparations of his budding two-year-old star Hennessy (Storm Cat), who will try to chalk up another one in the win column in next Sunday's GII feature at the Shore. The unbeaten colt worked a half-mile in :49, breezing, Saturday. "He galloped out strong," said Lukas. "He's coming up to the race in excellent shape. He's coming off an excellent race in the Hollywood Juvenile, and I think he'll be a factor--I think he'll be tough."

CRYPTIC BID BACK ON TRACK Three-year-old Cryptic Bid (Cryptoclearance), out since a series of setbacks beginning with surgery to remove chips from both ankles in mid-January, is back in training at Saratoga and will be ready for his first half-mile breeze within the week, according to trainer John Kimmel. A Triple Crown hopeful after showing brilliance at two, the colt developed colic after his ankle surgery and nearly lost his life. "The next day (after surgery), he's got colic," said Kimmel. "By the afternoon he hadn't responded to medication. There wasn't a surgery where we were in South Florida, so we vanned him to the university in Gainsville...they determined he needed surgical intervention." Undefeated in two starts last year, Cryptic Bid underwent colic surgery twice before finally turning the corner towards recovery. "He has responded well since then," said Kimmel. "He's gained weight, he eats well and he's training well. I'm cautiously optimistic that he'll get back to the races by late September. Then maybe, down the road, he'll be able to hook up with the likes of a Thunder Gulch again." Kimmel had both colts under his shedrow last fall.

MORE SURGERY FOR HAWLEY Jockey Sandy Hawley is likely to be sidelined longer than the two-tothree months he predicted Friday. The 46-year-old riding great said Saturday that further tests have revealed major damage to his urinary tract, which will require additional surgery in "about two months time." X-rays have also confirmed a cracked pelvis. "I should have been a doctor," Hawley was able to joke yesterday. "I told the ambulance attendants when they put me on the stretcher that I probably had some broken ribs and about my pelvis. I also told them I had internal damage because the pain was just excruciating." It is expected that Hawley will be out the rest of the season.


