SARATOGA '96 TO TWO MONTHS? The length of next year's Saratoga meet is anybody's guess after NYRA President/GM Kenny Noe Jr. said at vesterday's Fan's Forum at the racetrack that he is exploring several options for the 1996 meet, including an expansion to two months. Noe denied reports that the meet would likely be cut back to 30 days, and said that it would definitely not be cut back to its former length of 24 days. "I'm not leaning in any direction," said Noe. "Everything is under consideration. There's a possibility we'd stay here for two months starting in mid-July with a 5-day week," But Noe also said he realized the value of a short, seasonal meet. "When you had 24 days, everyone knew there were only those days when they could come. Now with 5 1/2 weeks, if the weather isn't that great one day, people say, 'I can come tomorrow." Noe said that at the end of the meeting, he would consider all options and is likely to make his recommendation to the NYRA Board of Trustees by November. Noe also said that he would like to explore the possibility of one day running the Breeders' Cup at Saratoga.

flat. "That was a hell of a move," said trainer D. Wayne
Lukas. "He took a giant step forward this morning. The
work was better than I was anticipating. He got off a
little quick, and he finished quick...and he didn't let up
at the wire." Lukas added that he did not have a specific race in mind for the Eclipse winner's return to
action, but the Jerome H. at Belmont September 4 has
