LURE TO STAND AT COOLMORE Lure (Danzig), who became the property of Lloyd's of London and Assicuazion Generali after the insurance underwriters settled a fertility claim on the former Claiborne stallion earlier this month, has been sold to Coolmore Stud in a deal overseen by Johnny McKeever, Director of Curragh Bloodstock Agency, and will stand the 1996 season in Ireland. Lure, a two-time Breeders' Cup Mile winner, failed to get over 60 percent of his mares tested in foal this year. Working through Andrew Mead Bloodstock, the underwriters received several sealed bids for the sixyear-old on the evening of August 10 and announced yesterday that Coolmore was the successful bidder. Breeders from England, America, Ireland and Japan had expressed interest. Said Christy Grasswick, Manager of Coolmore Stud, "We are happy with the deal we made with the underwriters. We hope that the experts who say Lure will improve are correct; we bought him on that basis. We are bullish about his chances and have commitments from top breeders who are interested in breeding to him next year. His stud fee will be announced at a later date."


