THUNDER GULCH STORMS TO

TRAVERS WIN Proving more powerful with each performance, Thunder Gulch (Gulch) let it be known vesterday that the race for Horse of the Year honors has not yet been won. Once considered no better than the third-best Team Lukas three-year-old, the colt stamped himself a champion with his decisive 4 1/2length score in the GI \$750,000 Travers S. at Saratoga, his fourth Grade I win of the year. "I think he's one of the best three-year-olds in a long time," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "You're going to have to go back in the record books a long way to find one who's done what he's done." Indeed, no horse has ever taken both the Swaps and the Travers after a Triple Crown campaign, and after dominating his division, Thunder Gulch will look for new worlds to conquer against the older horses--and his main rival for the ultimate Eclipse, Bill Mott trainee Cigar (Palace Music). Looking forward to the fall, Lukas said, "This horse beats other horses, and I think he'll continue to do that. I think Mott's plans will be affected by us. We're coming off two nice races in a 30-day interval and he's coming off a layoff. There will be some cat and mouse. We're looking at the Woodward...if Cigar runs there, so be it. It's a great series coming up. If you don't like racing in the fall at Belmont, you don't like racing."

HALL OF FAMER ADAMS PASSES AWAY

Johnny Adams, successful as both a jockey and a trainer, died yesterday morning at his home in Arcadia, California after a long illness. He was 79. Inducted into racing's Hall of Fame in 1965, Adams booted home more than 3,000 winners during his 24-year riding career; he won the Santa Anita H. in 1939 and 1946, and the Preakness in 1954. After retiring from the saddle in 1958, he conditioned such stakes winners as Niarkos, J.O. Tobin and Relaunch. In lieu of flowers, the family asked that donations be made to the Shoemaker Foundation or the Disabled Jockeys Fund.

Putting to rest any doubt as to who is the top threeyear-old, Thunder Gulch put in his most impressive effort to date, overcoming a slight bobble at the start to stalk the pace through moderate fractions before unleashing a stretch drive that carried him past Pyramid Peak and left him well in front for the three-year-old Eclipse Award. "Now when he's getting the lead, he's going on," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "Four months ago he would have run with that horse--now he's finding that extra gear and kicking in, and that's important in his development. Ever since the Swaps, he has been very aggressive." The chestnut is now six-for-eight on the year, and unbeaten at the Breeders' Cup Classic distance of a mile and a quarter. "He's such an athlete," said his jockey, Gary Stevens. "And once he sticks his head in front, he doesn't lose. Last fall at Aqueduct when I rode him for the first time, he didn't do anything right and he still won. I said to Wayne, 'he's got talent, but it's a game to him.' It's not a game any longer. He's got a job to do now that he loves. I'm looking forward to Breeders' Cup Day." The Travers Day total handle of \$20,336,881.68 was a Saratoga record, besting the previous mark of \$17,670,784 set Travers Day 1993. Weekend Results cont. p2
