TIMBER COUNTRY TO JAPAN Eclipse Award winner Timber Country (Woodman), retired this month after injuring a tendon, has been sold to the Shadai Stallion Station for a reported \$12 million and will stand the 1996 breeding season in Japan, according to today's Daily Racing Form. The three-year-old, a \$500,000 Keeneland sales yearling, made his final career start May 20, taking the GI Preakness; last year's champion two-year-old colt goes to the breeding shed with a record of five wins from 12 starts and earnings of \$1,560,400.

ALYWOW SECOND IN RETURN Alvwow

(Alysheba), Canada's 1994 Horse of the Year, returned from a nine-month layoff yesterday and finished second at 3-5 in the one-mile Victoriana Prep at Woodbine. The four-year-old filly, who had been sidelined by a hairline fracture of the cannon bone suffered last November, rated off the pace early and made a run down the lane but could not get to Bonnie Castle (Danzig Connection), who wired the field and won by 3 ½ lengths. "I was delighted," said trainer Roger Attfield. "She looks like she's back in tune again. A mile is tough on her when she's at her best, anyway. I liked the way she ran her last eighth of a mile. She got a tremendous amount out of this race." Attfield added that the champ could make her next start September 23, in either the Jockey Club Cup at Woodbine or the Flower Bowl H. at Belmont.

CALDER RACES TO NEW YORK An agreement has been reached between Calder Race Course and the New York Racing Association to simulcast the Calder races to Belmont Park and New York OTB on a full-card basis beginning September 7. The pools from the three sites will be commingled; the Calder races will be simulcast daily through October 5, then on Mondays only from October 7 through November 25. Plans for the end of the Calder meet, which runs through January 2, could include a return to daily simulcasting in New York after November 25, but plans have not been finalized.

The six-year-old has been tough in every start since coming up from South America, and he was giving away weight in his only two losses this year. It looks like he will be able to tuck in behind speedsters Kiri's Clown (Foolish Pleasure) and Manilaman (Manila), taking over as they straighten for home and looking to hold off the latecomers.

The pace should be quick enough to give the closers a chance. Northern Spur (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) made his '95 debut August 6, rallying to be third in the GI Eddie Read H. going a mile and an eighth at Del Mar. That race was a little short for the four-year-old, and the extra furlong here should benefit the European invader in his second U.S. start. 


