"This horse is very advanced for his age," said jockey Gary Stevens. "He runs like a very seasoned horse, a real professional. Before he ran, he didn't show any of us that he was this kind of horse, but once he got onto the track something clicked and he became serious. The scariest thing about him is that he didn't handle the track at all today. This track is much deeper than he's used to...but he overcame that to win. He's got that Storm Cat in him...when the gates open, they're nothing but racehorse and when they battle down the lane, it's war." The Team Lukas juvenile is now king of his crop; he will get a short break before taking on the pretenders to his throne in the GI Champagne S. at Belmont Park October 7. "I think the competition will get tougher as we go down the road, and I hope we will get tougher, too," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas.

FRENCH DEPUTY TO JEROME French Deputy

(Deputy Minister), once a top prospect for the 1995 Triple Crown, will make his first start since winning a Feb. 23 allowance at Santa Anita when he resurfaces in the Sept. 4 Jerome at Belmont. The colt, who has won all three career starts in California by a combined total of 18 ¾ lengths, was sidelined earlier this year with a foot injury. Trainer Neil Drysdale said he has not yet mapped out a post-Jerome schedule for the colt.
