RECORD NUMBER OF HORSES ENTERED IN KEENELAND NOVEMBER SALE Keeneland has received a record number of entries for its annual breeding stock sale, which is now scheduled for 11 days, Nov. 11 through Nov. 21, 1995. More than 3,970 horses have been entered, including a record 1,584 weanlings. Sessions are scheduled for 10 a.m. daily. The Frances A. Genter Stables will disperse its breeding stock, weanlings and yearlings during the first session of the sale, Saturday, Nov. 11. Walmac Farm will offer a major reduction during the sale and Loblolly Stable will complete the dissolution of its broodmare band. Mares will be sold in foal to leading sires Sadler's Wells, Mr. Prospector, Danzig, Storm Cat, Nureyey, Woodman and Gulch. Many of North America's leading sires are represented by weanlings in the sale. November will mark the second consecutive sale that Keeneland received a record number of entries. For the September Yearling Sale officials catalogued 3,705 horses, an all-time high.

NATIONAL HBPA RELOCATES The National Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association has completed the relocation of its national office under the auspices of Executive Director Scott Savin. The office's new location is in Aventura, Florida and its new telephone number is (305) 935-4700. The relocation was voted upon at the organization's summer convention; also accomplished was the installation of Bill Walmsley as President and Savin as Executive Director and National Spokesperson. Dr. Ed Hagan will continue as Chairman of the Board.

TEXAS YEARLING SALE FIRST SESSION

RESULTS The Texas Thoroughbred Association held the first of two sessions of its Summer Yearling Sale Monday, August 28, reporting significant increases over the figures from the first session of its 1994 sale. Forty nine Selected Thoroughbred Yearlings passed through the ring, bringing an average of \$16,621 and a median price of \$13,000. Those numbers reflect increases of 24.24 percent and 20.93 percent respectively over last year's numbers of \$13,378 and \$10,750. Monday's Open Session saw 279 yearlings average \$4,677 for a 42.59 percent increase over last year's average of \$3,280. Clever Lace, a dark bay or brown colt by Hadif—Lace Image (Vague Image), sold for a session-topping \$53,000 to Larry Brumbaugh and Vic Verstraete. The colt was consigned to the sale by Tommy Joe Hoyt.


Local News, Ohio:
