LASIX MAKES NEW YORK DEBUT It did not take New York trainers long to jump on the Lasix bandwagon. The diuretic will be allowed for the first time in New York Friday at Belmont Park and 46 of the 82 horses entered will be running on the medication. Twenty-eight horses will be running on Lasix for the first time. "We got some horses we wouldn't have had without Lasix," said Racing Secretary Mike Lakow. "We got a 'three-other than' to go with three out-oftown Lasix horses that may not have run here without it." Lakow said the entry process went smoothly, but he was worried there may be some glitches in the days ahead. "If there are going to be any complications they'll show up on opening day," he said. "For instance, if someone mistakenly entered with Lasix or if someone wanted it but failed to mention it to us. But so far, everyone's on the same wavelength." NYRA officials do not expect a large infusion of new horses at this meet, but are predicting that Lasix will have a major impact on field size at Aqueduct this winter.

#### KENTUCKY STATE RACING COMMISSION

RELEASES 1996 DATES The Kentucky State Racing Commission yesterday released the schedule of racing dates for the 1996 Kentucky racing season. Not included in the dates was Keeneland's proposed weeklong summer meeting. The 1996 Kentucky racing season kicks off with Turfway Park's Winter/Spring Meet, which will last 68 days from Jan. 1 through April 4. Racing then switches to Keeneland for its 15day Spring Meet from April 5 to April 26. Churchill Downs Spring and Summer Meet will be held from April 27 to June 30 for a total of 48 dates. July 2 through Sept. 2 Ellis Park will host a 56-day run, followed by Turfway's 23-day Fall Meet from Sept. 4 to Oct. 4. Also during the Turfway meeting, Dueling Grounds in Franklin, Ky. will host a nine-day meeting Sundays through Tuesdays Sept. 8 to Sept. 24. Next on the schedule is Keeneland's Fall Meet, which lasts 16 days from Oct. 5 to Oct. 26. Players Bluegrass Downs in Paducah picks up 22-dates from Sept. 28 through Oct. 27. Churchill Downs Fall Meet follows with 30 racing days Oct. 27 through Nov. 30. The 1996 season will conclude with the 22-day Holiday Meet at Turfway Park from Dec. 1 through Dec. 31.

CHULA VISTA H.-GII, \$300,000a, 3yo/up, f/m, 1 1/16m Four-time Grade I winner Lakeway (Seattle Slew) will carry highweight of 121 pounds, including jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. Delahoussaye piloted the four-year-old to a third-place finish in the Aug. 13 GII Rancho Bernardo Breeders' Cup H. in her first start back from a one-year hiatus. Lakeway drilled six furlongs in 1:10 at Del Mar Tuesday. Also working for the Chula Vista Tuesday were MSW Wild Lightning (Wild Again), who breezed five furlongs in 1:00 2/5, and GII A Gleam H. winner Angi Go (Idaho's Majesty), who went seven panels in 1:27. Working Wednesday at Del Mar was MGSW Golden Klair (GB) (Damister), who breezed five furlongs in 1:01. Also expected to run are GSW's Borodislew (Seattle Slew) and Top Rung (Seattle Slew). Lunar Spook (Silver Ghost) is a doubtful starter, according to trainer Bill Spawr. In addition, trainer Richard Mandella said 1993 Champion Juvenile Filly Phone Chatter (Phone Trick) will skip the Chula Vista in favor of the GII Palomar H. at 1 1/16-miles on the grass Sept. 9.

Working Tuesday for the GII event were Opera Score (Nureyev) and Regency (GB) (Dancing Brave), who covered seven furlongs over the main track in 1:28 3/5 and 1:27 2/5 respectively. Regency comes into Saturday's race off a nine-month layoff; the five-year-old last raced in the Dec. 11 GI Hollywood Turf Cup, in which he finished third. Also pointing to the race are Snake Eyes (Dixieland Band), who is the 118-pound highweight; Marvin's Faith (Ire) (Sharp Victor); River Rhythm (Riverman); Varadavour (Ire) (Lomond); Sans Ecocide (GB) (Hadeer {GB}): Royal Chariot (Strawberry Road {Aus}); and Rue du Fraise (Strawberry Road (Aus)).

TEXAS SALE CONCLUDES The Texas Thoroughbred Association concluded its two-day Summer Yearling Sale Tuesday with strong gains over the 1994 figures. Tuesday's open session saw 150 yearlings sell for a gross of \$765,000 and an average of \$5,100. The two open sessions following Monday's select sale combined for a total of 274 yearlings sold for a gross of \$1,341,800 and an average of \$4,897. That figure is up 49% from last year's average of \$3,280. A filly by Farma Way--Key to Damascus, consigned by Joseph F. Archer, President of the Texas TBA, brought the day's top price of \$30,000 from the day's leading purchaser, A.P. Gentry's Gentry Farms.
