HOOSIER PARK OPENS Hoosier Park in Anderson, Indiana began the state's first-ever Thoroughbred race meeting Friday night before 5,283 fans who wagered \$358,927 on the nine-race card. An additional \$283,686 was bet off-track. The total handle of \$642,613 was the second largest single-day live racing handle since Hoosier opened its doors Sept. 1, 1994 for a Standardbred meeting, "Our first evening of Thoroughbred racing went off without a hitch," said the track's general manager, Rick Moore. "Our hats are off to the staff, horsemen and fans who made this such a successful opening." The first winner was trained by Merrill Scherer, who, ironically, saddled the first horse across the finish line when Prairie Meadows opened in Iowa in 1989, but that winner was disqualified.

REGGIE HALPERN DEAD AT 89 According to a report in today's *Daily Racing Form*, Reggie Halpern, an Englishman who worked as a bookmaker in the U.S. until the trade was declared illegal in 1939, died Thursday morning at the Jewish Home and Hospital for the Aged after a brief illness. He was 89. A familiar figure at New York racetracks, Halpern earned some measure of fame as a guest of *Inside Racing with Harvey Pack*, reminiscing about the old days with veteran horseman Walter Kelley.

COBRA KING PREPS FOR DEL MAR FUTURITY Two-year-old Cobra King (Farma Way), likely favorite for the GII Del Mar Futurity September 13, breezed a half-mile in :49, handily, at the track yesterday. "It's all we wanted," said trainer Mike Puype. "He doesn't need much. He'll have a more serious move next Friday." The colt, now two-for-three, captured the GIII Balboa S. in his latest effort.

"She's done it well and I was delighted when the gap came," said Hammond. "I think the Prix de la Foret (at Longchamp in October) or the Breeders' Cup will be on her agenda."
