SERENA'S SONG--NUMBER ONE WITH A

BULLET And the hits just keep on coming. The duet of D. Wayne Lukas and Gary Stevens harmonized to take three of the last four Grade I events at Saratoga; they added yet another verse to the victory march as Serena's Song (Rahy) waltzed to an easy seven-length score in vesterday's GI Gazelle H. at Belmont Park. "She did a little bit of everything today --set a pace and held off a challenge," said Lukas. "I think this was one of her better races all year. She was a picture of composure in the paddock and hardly turned a hair." Lukas and Stevens, who captured the GI Travers with Thunder Gulch, the GI Hopeful with Hennessy and the GI Spinaway with Golden Attraction, have now picked up four of the last five Grade I stakes in New York. Already a winner over colts twice this year at nine furlongs and undefeated at the distance, Serena's Song could take on the devastating Heavenly Prize in the mile-and-aneighth Beldame October 7 next out. "Nobody would be looking forward to facing Heavenly Prize, but I don't think Shug (McGaughey) is too excited about facing us either," said Lukas, who added that he would also consider the Kentucky Cup September 23 and the Spinster October 7 for his three-year-old diva.

NUMBERS UP AT MONMOUTH PARK Monmouth Park, which celebrated its 50th anniversary season this year, closed out the '95 meet yesterday with gains in both handle and attendance. The total Monmouth handle was over \$113 million, up 11 percent over 1994, while on-track attendance was 688,732, up slightly from 687,363 a year ago. This marked the first year that Monmouth offered full-card simulcasting; over \$24 million was wagered on outof-state cards during the summer meet. "We were really pleased with our ability to integrate all the full cards signals unobtrusively into our live program," said Executive Vice President Hal Handel. "We were also pleasantly surprised by the acceptance of all the out-of-state signals we offered." Jockey Joe Bravo led the riders for an unprecedented fifth straight time, while Juan Serey nosed out last year's champ Danny Lopez for the trainer's title; Ebby Novack's New Farm was the meet's leading owner. With jockey Gary Stevens once again in the irons, the filly broke sharply and pressed Alabama winner PRETTY DISCREET (Private Account) to the far turn, then cruised up to take the lead, shaking off a brief challenge from Miss Golden Circle and galloping away from the field to her fifth Grade I win of the year. Said Stevens, "She's starting to peak and this is the right time of year to do it. Inside the eighth pole, I chirped to her twice and she just responded. Like Tom Durkin said, it was a champion performance. She really put on a show today." Miss Golden Circle outgamed stablemate Golden Bri for the place spot; it was her fourth straight second in a row. Said her trainer, John Kimmel, "I think my filly ran very well out there today. However, she's no Serena's Song. There was no beating her today...she's awesome." Kimmel will point the runner-up for the Cotillion H. at Philadelphia Park September 23, while Golden Bri, winner of the Coaching Club American Oaks in July, will get a "well-deserved breather."

The G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. over a mile at Ascot later this month is now the target for Ridgewood Pearl, the champion miler-elect of Europe. The John Oxx-trained filly cruised along behind SMOLENSK (Danzig) and DARNAY (Darshaan) early on while racing on the rail; Darnay dropped out of it as they turned into the straight and it was only a matter of when the winner would take over. A furlong and a half out, she went through a gap between Smolensk and the rail and although briefly challenged by Shaanxi and Missed Flight inside the final furlong, Ridgewood Pearl was always in command. She adds this to her course record-setting win in the G1 Coronation S. at Ascot in June and her Irish 1000 Guineas triumph and gives her Irish trainer his first G1 success in France. "This was her biggest test yet and it was good to see her take on and beat the colts and older horses in this race," said Oxx. "She also came into this race after an 11-week absence--it was a good performance."

THE MEADOWLANDS OPENS WITH RECORD

PURSES The Meadowlands launches its 19th Thoroughbred season this afternoon with record overnight purses, free admission and the meet's only daytime card, with first post set for 12:30 p.m. EDT. "We're coming into this meet off a strong Monmouth season and anticipate that momentum can carry right into The Meadowlands," said Executive Vice President and General Manager Hal Handel. Overnight purses, which have been raised seven times in the past two seasons, will begin at a record \$184,000 per card. The GIII Boiling Springs H., the traditional opening-day feature, had to be split into two divisions for the first time since 1990; it is the first of 67 stakes scheduled for the 67-day meeting, which concludes December 9.
