THUNDER GULCH, CIGAR MEETING ON

HOLD? Kentucky Derby, Belmont S. and Travers S. winner **Thunder Gulch** (Gulch) worked yesterday morning over Belmont's main track, breezing five furlongs in 1:00.44. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said he is not sure whether the three-year-old colt will meet Horse of the Year frontrunner **Cigar** (Palace Music) in the Sept. 16 Woodward S. "I'm sure the two horses will meet up," said the trainer, "but I have to be clear in saying I am not committed to run in the Woodward. I'm sure they will meet up in the Breeders' Cup Classic, but I have another option for Thunder Gulch. There's the Kentucky Cup Classic on Kentucky Cup Day (Sept. 23 at Turfway Park) that would give us a good split of time in between races for the Breeders' Cup." Meanwhile, trainer Bill Mott said Cigar is training forwardly for the GI Woodward. "We worked him an easy half in :50 2/5 (Sunday) and he came out of that real good," Mott said. "He's had plenty of time to recover. He raced hard, got tired and now has had 2½-months of time on his side. He's very sharp now. He acts good, is carrying some good flesh and is moving really well." The five-year-old has won his last nine starts, including six Grade I events; he last raced July 2, taking the GI Hollywood Gold Cup by 3½-lengths.

DANIEL GALBREATH DEAD Daniel M. Galbreath, the owner of Darby Dan Farm, died Sunday after a long battle with cancer. He was 67 years old. Born in Columbus, Ohio, where he lived until his death, Galbreath was the president of the 1960, 1971 and 1979 World Champion Pittsburgh Pirates, and chairman and CEO of The Galbreath Company, a private, full-service real estate development, management and leasing firm. He was a Director of Churchill Downs, the Keeneland Association, and a Member of The Jockey Club. Under the stewardship of the late John Galbreath, Darby Dan campaigned such stars as 1963 Kentucky Derby and Belmont winner Chateaugay, 1974 Preakness and Belmont winner Little Current, 1985 Breeders' Cup Classic winner Proud Truth, and 1972 Epsom Derby winner Roberto.

Making his first start since taking a Santa Anita allowance by 11 lengths February 23, French Deputy tried stakes company for the first time as the 3-2 choice and proved ready for the step up. Allowed to settle just off the leaders for three-quarters, the homebred colt took command when asked for speed and cruised away from the field to win as his jockey pleased. "He basically galloped around and at the quarter pole I asked him and he accelerated. He just went about his business," said Gary Stevens. Trainer Neil Drysdale added, "This horse has been away for a long time, so I was worried about his conditioning. I was very pleased with the way he ran." As for the future, Drysdale said, "We wanted to see where we stood after this race and then map out a program. I think the Breeders' Cup Classic is a possibility."

TWELVE SET FOR BRITISH ST. LEGER Britain's bookmakers are banking on a field of 12 for this Saturday's Pertemps-sponsored St. Leger. There are 15 five-day entries for the Doncaster race. But three of them--**Affidavit** (Affirmed), **Larrocha (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Swain (Ire)** (Nashwan)--look set to miss the final classic of 1995. The probable lineup is: **Anchor Clever (GB)** (Slip Anchor {GB}), **Classic Cliche (Ire)** (Salse), **Court of Honour (Ire)** (Law Society), **In Camera (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), **Istidaad** (Chief's Crown), **Jellaby Ashkir (GB)** (Salse), **Jural (GB)** (Kris {GB}), **Kalabo** (Tremolino), **Luso (GB)** (Salse), **Minds Music** (Silver Hawk), **Presenting (GB)** (Mtoto {GB}) and **Sanmartino (Ire)** (Salse).
