MILLION-DOLLAR PICK SIX PAYOUT AT DEL

MAR A Del Mar and Southern California record Pick Six payoff of \$1,039,259.20 was registered Thursday on a single ticket sold at the seaside track. The winning ticket was purchased for \$216. The ticket combined two favorites, two second favorites, one third favorite and a 31-1 longshot, Half Mamoon, for the record win. The previous high for a single Pick Six payoff in Southern California was \$978,229.60 at Santa Anita February 28, 1986. No name was given for the lucky handicapper holding the million-dollar ticket.

ABBREVIATED ARLINGTON MEET SHOWS A

LOSS The bottom line for the 55-day Arlington International Racecourse meeting that ended Monday was a 13-percent decline on net betting revenue for the track when measured against the same calendar days last year, when the meet covered 131 days. Full-card simulcast from out of state, just legalized by the Illinois state legislature, was the major contributing factor to the decline; commissions on out-of-state bets are lower than on Arlington's own races. On-track betting on Arlington's programs was down 29 percent, Illinois intertrack betting was down 59 percent and Illinois off-track betting was down 52 percent. However, because of simulcast betting, total handle increased 1 percent. The full-card simulcasts produced \$73,761,113, which represents 42 percent of the \$174,950,503 total handle generated by Arlington and its intertrack and OTB outlets. The simulcast revenue generated by the new law was a boon to horsemen--their Arlington purses went from \$188,000 in '94 to \$235,000 in '95.

DUSTY SCREEN RETIRES TO BUCK POND

FARM **Dusty Screen** (Silent Screen), a multiple graded-stakes winner of \$623,935, has been purchased by a syndicate to stand stud at Buck Pond Farm in Versailles, Kentucky next season. The seven-year-old, who captured the GIII National Jockey Club H. and GIII Salvator Mile, last raced July 29, finishing eighth to GI Iselin H. winner Schossberg in this year's Salvator Mile. He goes to stud with a record of 18 wins from 46 career starts. Said Douglas Arnold, owner of Buck Pond, "This horse brings front-running, miler speed and classic stamina to our farm." Dusty Screen will stand for a fee of \$3,500, live foal.

MARYLAND'S TOP JOCK INJURED Jockey Mark Johnston, the leading rider at Pimlico's spring and Laurel's winter and summer meets, suffered a displaced fracture of the right collarbone when he was thrown from his mount in yesterday's third race after the field had crossed the finish line. Maryland's top rider last year, Johnston is expected to be out for six weeks, but his agent, Gordon Becraft, said he hoped his rider could be back in time for the Maryland Million in five weeks.
