CALDER CUTS PURSES AGAIN For the second time during the current meeting, Calder President Ken Dunn has been forced to cut purses. "We've overpaid the purses by more than \$500,000 and there are only 40 racing days remaining before we finish the summer meeting. I've got to balance the books on this," said Dunn. The overpayment could be reconciled during next year's Calder summer meet, "But I don't want to carry a half-million dollar deficit over to next year," Dunn added. Beginning with Thursday's overnight, purses will drop by 13 percent to an average of \$88,000 a day, down from \$101,000 per day. Purses were averaging \$105,000 a day at the beginning of the meet. The Calder president remarked, "I don't think we would be in this situation if the state would allow us to simulcast. We are hoping to work something out with them soon."

#### CANADIAN BREEDERS SALES FIRST SESSION

RESULTS The Canadian Breeders' Sales held the first of two sessions of its select Canadian-bred yearling sale at Woodbine Thursday night. There were 63 yearlings sold for a total of \$1,567,400 and an average of \$24,879. The night's highest priced yearling at \$115,000 was a chestnut colt by Private Account-Reasonable Sin (Sinister Purpose). Consigned by Michael C. Byrne, agent, the colt, a half-brother to MSW and \$227,257-earner Native Factor (Foolish Pleasure), was purchased by Edna P. Benson. Byrne, as agent, also sold the second highest-priced yearling of the session, a dark bay or brown colt by Alwuhush out of the multiple stakes-winning mare Bees 'n' Honey (Geiger Counter). The colt was purchased for \$73,000 by Stephen Chiu.

CHRIS ANTLEY SIDELINED An injury that plagues baseball pitchers primarily has benched jockey Chris Antley for the remainder of the Del Mar meet. Antley is suffering from a rotator cuff injury in his right shoulder. The jockey injured the shoulder in a starting-gate mishap recently. Charlie McCaul, in charge of the Del Mar jockeys' room, said Antley had complained that he wasn't able to raise his arm enough to be effective with the whip.

Classic Cliche, made the 10-3 favorite after the late withdrawal of Presenting, gave the Maktoum family their 8th English Classic win in a row. He also gave his jockey Frankie Dettori his 1,000th winner in Britain (his first was at Goodwood in 1987). Classic Cliche was always well placed in 2nd or 3rd behind the frontrunning filly JURAL (GB) (Kris {GB}), then took the lead with ½mile to run and from then on was never challenged, coming home to win easily. "What a great way to reach 1,000," said Dettori. "I'm very proud to have done it in a classic. This was the first time Classic Cliche had the ground to his liking. I knew he would be a St. Leger horse. He is a big, tall horse and has lots of stamina. Sometimes pedigrees can be deceiving. This was a great thrill for me." This marked Dettori's third Classic win in Britain, following scores with Balanchine and Moonshell. The win, Classic Cliche's first in a G1 event, boosted trainer Saeed bin Suroor's prize money in Britain this year to \$2,826,403 from only 13 wins. No fixed plans have yet been made for the colt's next start, although Simon Crisford, Godolphin's racing manager, did suggest he might be campaigned in North America this autumn. "He'll definitely stay in training for next year," Crisford added.
