### **RECORD KEENELAND SEPTEMBER**

SALE BEGINS TODAY A record 3,705 horses have been catalogued for Keeneland's annual September Yearling Sale, which begins today at Keeneland Racecourse in Lexington. A total of 1,951 colts, 1,749 fillies and five geldings will be offered during the 10-day auction, which concludes September 20. In 1994, for the second year in a row, the September Sale set records for gross sales --\$104,709,900--and average--\$37,171. "Based on July and other sales throughout the country, we anticipate an outstanding sale with strong American participation," said Keeneland's Director of Sales Rogers Beasley. "There is also considerable interest from Europe and Japan." Beasley also noted that there has been a strong demand for catalogs and hotel reservations and said consignors have been busy showing yearlings to prospective buyers at their farms. Represented this year are most of North America's most popular sires, including: 11 by Seattle Slew, 4 by Danzig, 4 by Riverman, 25 by Storm Cat. 8 by Nureyev, 15 by Seeking the Gold, 21 by Deputy Minister and 28 by Woodman. A.P. Indy, the leading first-crop sire at the recently July Selected Yearling Sale with an average of \$400,000, has eight yearlings in the sale. Gulch, who leads the general sire list, is represented by 14. Black Tie Affair, America's leading first-crop sire of winners, appears as the sire of 51 yearlings. Sales sessions start daily at 10 a.m. Results will be available on the Internet soon after the completion of each sales session at: http://www.equineonline.com/tjcis/index.html.

CORDERO RETURNS SUNDAY Angel Cordero Jr. has confirmed that he will begin his comeback as a rider this Sunday at El Commandante in his native Puerto Rico. Cordero will ride possible Breeders' Cup Sprint candidate Bandito Bomber (Prosperous) in a 7-furlong allowance race. The four-year-old Puerto Rican champ is 27-for-29 lifetime. If all goes well, he may come to New York for the Boojum H. Cordero was at El Commandante vesterday, riding the horse in a public workout. PIGGOTT HANGS UP HIS HELMET Lester Piggott, 59, winner of over 4,500 races in Britain, has announced his decision to retire from riding. Piggott allowed his riding license to expire this spring and has revealed he has no plans to renew it. "I'm tired of struggling to keep my weight down," said Piggott. "I've had a long career and could have gone on, but, eventually, you don't want to do it anymore, even though you know you'll miss it. I've had offers to ride again, but, when you've got a problem with your weight, it's just no fun. I've decided to pack it in." Born Nov. 5, 1925, Piggott rode his first winner at the age of 12 at Haydock Park. He quickly built a reputation as a fearless competitor and often ran afoul of racing authorities, but the British racing public loved him and his phenomenal will to win. He would go on to win nine Epsom Derbies before first announcing his retirement in 1985. But after a year spent in prison for tax evasion, he made a sensational comeback in 1990, thrilling his fans with a win on Royal Academy in the 1990 Breeders' Cup Mile. "It was the most terrific day," said Piggott yesterday, who admitted he was unsure of what the future held for him now. "I don't think I want to train... I haven't really thought about what I'm going to do. At the moment, I'm just enjoying a rest."


