### SILVER HAWK COLT TOPS KEENELAND'S FOURTH SESSION A chestnut colt by Silver Hawk--Upper Class Lady (Upper Nile) topped Thursday's fourth session of the 1995 Keeneland September Yearling Sale. Previously sold for \$42,000 as a weanling at the '94 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, the colt brought a session-topping \$310,000 vesterday from buyer John Warren, agent, of Newmarket, England. Overall, 287 yearlings were sold Thursday for a gross of \$14,603,000 and an average of \$50,882 up 25.8 percent from last year's fourth session average of \$40,450. The median price of \$42,000 represented a 31 percent increase from last year's \$32,000. After the first four days of the 10-day auction, 1,168 horses have gone through the sales ring, bringing \$96,697,000 for an average of \$82,789. This represents a 30 percent increase from 1994, when the average after the first four sessions was \$63,624. The sale continues through Wednesday, Sept. 20.

#### DEL MAR HANDLE SETS CALIFORNIA

**RECORD** Setting a new standard in California, the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club posted a mark of \$484,347.542 in total handle and \$11,263,896 in daily average handle for the 1995 meet which ended Wednesday. Up 8.9 percent from last years totals, the figures, which include on-track, 16 Southern California inter-track wagering satellites, 50 commingling hub locations, 14 separate pool hubs and, for the second year, 17 Northern California sites, are both records in the state. On-track handle was down 1.5 percent from a year ago, but the commingled wagering from out-of-state and Northern California on the Del Mar card was up 21.1 percent. The track also set a single-day handle mark August 19 when \$15,506,324 was wagered. While on-track attendance dropped 5.1 percent, from 16,009 in '94 to 15,187 in '95, Del Mar is still number one in the country in total attendance, attracting an average of 33,150 visitors both on and off-track daily. It also boasts the country's highest daily purse distribution, paying out an average of \$402,827 per day during the 43-day meet.

### FHBPA SUPPLEMENTS TWO-YEAR-OLD

PURSES AT CALDER The Canadian Supplemental fund designed by the Florida HBPA has come to the aid of Calder horsemen who have just seen two dramatic cuts to the Calder purse schedule. The fund, designed with the concept of supplementing purses for two-yearold racing at Calder in the summer, will now be doubled so that purses for horsemen racing two-year-olds from a level of maiden claiming \$25,000 and up through maiden allowance conditions as well as non-winners of one and two other than will not see reduced purses at Calder Racecourse. Calder has been hampered through its summer meet with an on-track decline in both attendance and handle. A large portion of this decline has been attributed to the inability to obtain full-card simulcasting permission from the State of Florida. The ability to double the supplemental monies provided for in the Canadian fund demonstrates the fiscal responsibility of the FHBPA, which continues to lobby in Tallahassee and with racetrack management for the elevation of horsemen's economic rights.

HALLING CLASSIC-BOUND Halling (Diesis {GB}), winner this year of Britain's G1 Coral Eclipse S. at Sandown and G1 Juddmonte International at York, will run next in the Breeders' Cup Classic at Belmont. The four-year-old Kentucky-bred, who races in the Godolphin silks, had been expected to compete in Ascot's Queen Elizabeth II S. next weekend. But, following a minor setback, he is taking a short break before flying to America. Simon Crisford, racing manager to Godolphin, said, "Halling will miss Ascot. But the injury will not rule him out of an autumn campaign and he will now be aimed at the Breeders' Cup Classic."


#### AUTOTOTE'S PROPOSITION WAGER A

SUCCESS Trainer Mike Mitchell won the training title at the 1995 Del Mar meet, which ended Wednesday night, giving fans who wagered on his success in Autotote Enterprises "King of the Hill" proposition wager a \$200.80 payoff. Mitchell, who sent out 18 winners during the 43-day meet, went off at odds of 99-1. Jockey Chris McCarron rode Helmsman to victory in the last race Wednesday to capture the rider's title with 48 winners. A win ticket on McCarron paid \$53.40. A total of \$3,095 was wagered on the proposition bet. "Considering we only had six days to promote the wager, we're pleased with the results," said Rick Cowan, president and CEO of Autotote Enterprises. "We hope to give racing fans more proposition-type wagers in the near future. I think they have a broad appeal, add a

new dimension and are fun for the fans." Bettors were offered the opportunity to wager on who would be the leading rider and trainer at the Del Mar meet. Wagering was accepted at all Connecticut Off-Track Betting branches, the Bradley Teletheater in Windsor Locks, Connecticut, Sports Haven in New Haven and through Autotote's "On the Wire" phone wagering service.
