SUPERSTARS SHINE ON SUPER

SATURDAY Cigar (Palace Music) smoked 'em in the Woodward; Inside Information (Private Account) took the inside track to the winner's circle in the Ruffian; Millkom (GB) (Cyrano de Bergerac) was the man of the hour in the Man O'War. Super Saturday at Belmont Park provided no less than six Breeders' Cup candidates with a platform, and the stars simply sparkled. Two-year-old filly Golden Attraction (Mr. Prospector) retained her head-of-the-class credentials with a game victory in the Matron at 2-5; juvenile Maria's Mon (Wavering Monarch) regained respect with a decisive score in the Futurity. Then it was time for the big guns to fire. Facing five overmatched rivals. Inside Information was pounded down to 1-10 but never gave her backers an anxious moment, visiting with the field for a half-mile before going about her business; the four-year-old came home 11 lengths in front, but it could have been many more. "She's just amazing," said jockey Mike Smith. "You would pay for a ride like that." The filly gave away from 12 to 18 pounds, and trainer Shug McGaughey said he would now look for weight-for-age events for his charge. "I don't want to run her in any more handicaps--I can't lift that kind of weight anymore," he offered. A full field of 13 were kept waiting in the gate for the start of the Vosburgh as Our Emblem (Mr. Prospector) fought with the crew, finally backing into his slot with the aid of a blindfold. But the cantankerous colt missed getting his picture taken by the bob of two heads, rallying for third behind the dead-game Not Surprising (Medieval Man) and You And I (Kris S.) in a preview of the Breeders' Cup Sprint. The finish of the Man O'War was a different kind of thriller; Millkom, one of the best horses in Europe last year but off-form this season, looked back at his best as the easiest kind of 1 1/4-length winner. The British-bred tugged on jockey Gary Stevens from the start, dragging him to the lead in midstretch and holding Kaldounevees (Fr) (Kaldoun) safe without extending himself. But if the Man O'War was a walk in the park, then the Woodward was an absolute stroll. Unchallenged since stepping out on the main track, Cigar looked a lock to take his 10th straight--and he did it in a laugher. "At no time was I ever concerned," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "The only surprise was looking up on the board and seeing how fast he went, considering how easily he did it." Said trainer Bill Mott, "He is the best horse I've ever trained. He may be the best horse anyone ever trained." (Super Saturday Charts, p1-3)

Keeping his main track record unblemished by defeat, Cigar came back from two-month break as the 1-10 favorite. Making his first start in New York this year, the bright bay was content to rate in third behind frontrunning Star Standard, then moved to the lead at will, opening it up at the top of the stretch and coasting home to vet another effortless score. "I didn't have any real anxious moments," said trainer Bill Mott. "By the time he left the half-mile pole, he was in gear. I think we're leaning toward starting him next in the Jockey Club Gold Cup (October 7)." Three-year-old Star Standard ran on well to be second after throwing in a couple of clunkers at Saratoga. "We almost pulled it off," said trainer Nick Zito. "He's a much better horse than he showed in Saratoga. He didn't like that track at all." The one disappointment in the race was second-choice SCHOSSBERG (Broad Brush). The winner of the GI Iselin H. in his latest raced in close contention from the start but weakened in the drive and finished fourth. "I couldn't tell you what went wrong today," said trainer Phillip England, "Perhaps Cigar looked him in the eye the wrong way and he backed down."

The bay, purchased by owner Gary Tanaka three weeks ago, will now go to trainer Rodney Rash. The 2-1 favorite TIKKANEN (Cozzene), making his first start July and looking for his first win since last year's Breeders' Cup Turf, was in traffic and tired late. "I didn't have a great trip," said jockey Mike Smith. "But he needed the race, and he should improve." Tikkanen and runner-up Kaldounevees will run next in the Turf Classic Oct. 7.

Bidding for his fourth straight graded victory and his first in Grade I company, Not Surprising indeed did not surprise the crowd on hand for Super Saturday. Sent off the slight choice in the full field of 13, the big red gelding stalked the pace of You And I and LITE THE FUSE (Buckaroo) to the stretch, went up to challenge when You And I took the lead, and was all out to win the three-way photo. "He did everything I asked of him, and I had to ask him early, too--earlier than I would've liked," said rider Robbie Davis. "He just put in a great race. It was a wild finish ... man, they were ganging up on him. But all he did was fight, fight, fight. He's all heart." The winner will make his next start in the Breeders' Cup Sprint. You And I, gallant in defeat, will also make his next start in the Sprint. Our Emblem, who held up the start of the race when very difficult to load, finished well but had to settle for third; future plans are undecided. "He ran well despite acting up at the starting gate," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "I had this problem with him before when he was a two-year-old. It probably took his interest out of running--he was mad. I've seen him mad before, and it's not a pretty sight."
