RECORD WAGERS ON CIGAR, INSIDE

INFORMATION The total figure of \$1,798,673 bet on Cigar (Palace Music) to show in Saturday's Woodward S. at Belmont is believed to be the most money ever wagered on a horse in a single win, place or show pool in the history of New York racing. Of the total show pool of \$1,841,884, \$1,193,910 was wagered in Las Vegas. Cigar's victory created a total minus show pool of \$335,607, also a New York record. The mark Cigar broke was short-lived; the previous high was believed to be the \$1,594,176 bet to show on Inside Information (Private Account) in the Ruffian H. earlier on the Super Saturday card. Of the total Ruffian show pool of \$1,642,953, \$1,127,648 was wagered in Las Vegas. Those bets created a minus show pool of \$292,796. It is rumored that one Las Vegas bettor made \$500,000 show wagers on both horses at the Las Vegas Club Race Book.

FRENCH DEPUTY EYES OPTIONS French Deputy (Deputy Minister), the winner of the Sept. 4 Gll Jerome H. at Belmont Park, will make his next start in either the Sept. 30 \$750,000 Super Derby or the Oct. 6 \$500,000 Meadowlands Cup, according to trainer Neil Drysdale, who said that a decision will be made shortly. "I'm not eager to face Cigar (Palace Music) any time soon," said Drysdale, who has ruled out the Oct. 7 Jockey Club Gold Cup as a possible start. "I don't think it would make much sense to run against Cigar at a mile and a quarter right now. French Deputy hadn't run in seven months, and (the Jerome) was a pretty strong race, so I think it's a pretty good idea to give him time between his races."

DUELING GROUND CANCELS Sunday's four-race card at Dueling Grounds in Franklin, Kentucky, was cancelled after heavy rains soaked the turf course. "After walking the course early Sunday morning, we decided it would be in the best interest of everyone involved to cancel the races, work the track, let it dry and concentrate on Monday's eight-race program," said Gary Wilfert, Dueling Grounds general manager and director of racing. Sunday's feature, the Jim Bowie S. for two-year-olds at a mile, has been rescheduled for next Sunday. Post time for today's eight-race card is 1:00 p.m.


