LAUREL ANNOUNCES FALL/WINTER STAKES SCHEDULE The 10th edition of the Maryland Million headlines the upcoming fall/winter stakes schedule at Laurel Park. In addition to Maryland Million Day, set for October 14, Laurel will offer 22 stakes, including five graded races, worth a total of $\$ 1,710,000$ in purses. A further 15 -race, $\$ 520,0000$ overnight stakes program will also be offered. The centerpiece of the 68 -day meet, Maryland Million Day consists of 11 races for the offspring of Maryland-based stallions. The featured event is the $\$ 200,000$ Maryland Million Classic, a 1 3/16-mile test for three-year-olds and up. The card also includes the $\$ 125,000$ Maryland Million Ladies, six \$100,000 stakes, a \$50,000 handicap, a \$25,000 distaff starter handicap and a \$25,000 steeplechase. The Laurel Fall/Winter Meet opens Tuesday, October 3.


DANEHILL COLT TOPS TATTERSALLS SALE A colt by Danehill--Faakirah (GB) (Dragonara Palace) consigned by Croom House Stud brought a bid of 45,000 guineas from Jack Doyle to top Tattersalls' 1995 September Yearling Sale, held September 19-20 in Dublin, Ireland. In all, a total of 415 yearlings were sold for a gross of $2,376,057$ guineas, averaging 5,725 guineas.

## PEMBROKE TO STAND AT HERMITAGE

Pembroke (Gone West), who set a world record for 5.5 furlongs on the turf in 1:00 2/5 July 15 at Hollywood Park, will stand the 1996 breeding season at Hermitage Farm in Goshen, Kentucky. The five-year-old has won seven of 17 lifetime starts, and is a $3 \times 5 W$, including his record-setting performance in the Hollywood Budweiser Breeders' Cup. He has earned \$270,748. A half-brother to GISW Nasty and Bold (Naskra), Pembroke will race in the colors of Darley Stud until the conclusion of his racing career. He will stand for $\$ 5,000$ live foal.

TRF AUCTION RAISES $\mathbf{\$ 1 3 , 0 0 0}$ Mark and Nancy Foley of Vermont bid \$1,100 for Fred Stone's portrait of Man o'War to take home the sales topper from the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation's annual racing memorabilia auction held September 16 at Belmont Park. The Foleys also paid $\$ 420$ for Sky Beauty's Breeders' Cup Distaff saddlecloth and $\$ 325$ for an autographed limited edition lithograph entitled "Legendary Athletes." The 68 -item auction raised a total of \$13,000.

Making his second start off a two-month break after bucking his shins when fifth in his stakes debut and lone defeat, the GIll Riva Ridge June 10, Flying Chevron followed a Belmont allowance score with this frontrunning victory over 2-5 favorite Da Hoss. Showing a fondness for the footing in his first start beyond seven furlongs, the dark bay colt sprinted to a clear lead from the start and was never really threatened, coasting home under jockey Robbie Davis. "It really was an easy trip," said Davis. "We had a question about whether he would go two turns. He answered that tonight, and he really handled the track well. I sensed Da Hoss coming up on me...but we were getting 10 pounds and! knew we would be tough." The crowd's choice moved to challenge after three-quarters but could not run with the winner down the lane, settling for second. Odds-on favorites are now 0 -for-four in the Pegasus; jockey Jerry Bailey, aboard Da Hoss this year, is 0 -for-seven in the race, and 0 -for-three with Pegasus favorites. "At the top of the stretch he gave his run, but the other one just sprinted away from him," said Bailey.
