"THUNDER" ROLLS, BUT "STORM" STYMIES KENTUCKY CUP SWEEP Team

Lukas swept through four of the five major Kentucky Cup stakes at Turfway Park yesterday, but the limelight lost some luster for the stable when reigning three-year-old queen Serena's Song (Rahy) went down to defeat in the Turfway Budweiser Breeders' Cup. "It's amazing how this game plays. We had a banner day, but the filly losing gets you down," said D. Wayne Lukas, who becomes the all-time leading stakes-winning trainer at Turfway with 13 stakes victories. "As they say, the good is never as good as the bad is bad. The loss leaves you kind of flat because Serena's Song is a special horse, but considering the big picture, how can you not be grateful?" Lukas marched out Tipically Irish (Metfield) to take the Juvenile Fillies, Editor's Note (Forty Niner) to victory in the Juvenile and Lord Carson (Carson City) to capture the Sprint, but 1-5 Serena's Song could not keep the streak alive, falling five-and-a-half lengths short of Mariah's Storm (Rahy) after racing on even terms with the winner at the top of the stretch. "No real excuses," said her jockey, Gary Stevens. "She felt great and pulled up great after the race. She just got limber-legged the last eighth of a mile. I haven't lost any confidence in her; she's had a tough year and they all get beat sometime. We'll see what happens Breeders' Cup Day." Team Lukas bounced back for the Kentucky Cup climax. Looking for his fourth straight, Thunder Gulch (Gulch) was also bet down to 1-5 despite giving from five to nine pounds to his mostly older rivals, but the weight didn't stop him. Overcoming insignificant contact early, the three-year-old champ rallied from fifth to win the Kentucky Cup Classic by a length. Stevens, aboard for the victory, said, "This colt is a fighter. Once he opened up at the sixteenth pole, the race was basically over. But he reverted back to his old ways today. When he made the lead, he wanted to play a bit. He wasn't real serious about anything that was going on." Lukas will certainly have the colt serious for his next start, when he will face Cigar in either the Jockey Club Gold Cup October 7 or the Breeders' Cup Classic October 28; the trainer said Thunder Gulch is "50-50" for the Gold Cup.

On the far turn, Mariah's Storm and Serena's Song moved past the leader, with the 1-5 favorite drawing up alongside the winner at the quarter pole but unable to match strides down the lane, suffering her first defeat of the year at a distance less than a mile and a quarter. "She ran a flat one today," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas of the crowd's choice. "I guess they're all subject to do that. She just didn't pick it up and fire. The other filly ran terrific." Said winning trainer Donnie Von Hemel, "I can't say I thought we were going to beat Serena's Song, but I thought we had a chance to beat her. You don't get any higher than this. A lot of credit goes to my father, who had this filly early in her career, and my brother, and to our assistant here, Thad Keller. It's really a team effort...it's a great thrill to win with everyone involved like that." As for the winner's future. Von Hemel said he will consider the Spinster and/or the Breeders' Cup Distaff.

CHRB RULES ON 1996 RACING CALENDAR The California Horse Racing Board Friday approved the 1996 racing calendar for Thoroughbred meets in southern California, but acting on a request by certain racing associations and fairs, the Board delayed action for 30 days on the northern California Thoroughbred and all fair meetings. As approved, the winter meeting at Santa Anita will open Dec. 26 and run through April 22, followed by meets at Hollywood (April 24-July 22), Del Mar (July 24-Sept. 11), Santa Anita (Oct. 2-Nov. 4), and Hollywood (Nov. 6-Dec. 22). Members of the Thoroughbred Owners of California said they will meet with the southern racing associations in an effort to work out modifications to the 1996 calendar and major changes to the 1997 calendar.

The California Horse Racing Board has approved an amendment which will change the payoffs involving dead-heats in the state's daily triple pools. The modification will allow for different payoffs in the case of dead-heats, with each payout reflecting the proportionate amount of money wagered on each winning combination. "Fans have been telling us that it isn't fair for the holder of a winning daily triple ticket on a favorite to get paid the same as someone with a winning ticket on a longshot when the two horses finish in a dead-heat," said CHRB Commissioner George Nicholaw. "This amendment gives the fans what they want. Now if their horses finish in a dead-heat, they'll get paid off according to the odds."
