HIS MAJESTY DEAD His Majesty (*Ribot), sire of more than 50 stakes winners and a leading broodmare sire as well, was humanely destroyed last Thursday at Lexington's Darby Dan Farm due to the infirmities of old age. He was 27. The leading sire of 1981 produced American champions Pleasant Colony and Tight Spot, Italian champion Panjandrum and Mexican champion Asaltante. He also has sired six Grade I winners including Cormorant, sire of Kentucky Derby winner Go for Gin; his progeny have earned more than \$24 million to date.

MISTER BAILEYS TO ARRIVE AT VINERY The 1994 British Two Thousand Guineas winner Mister Baileys (GB) (Robellino) will leave England October 3, 1995 for Vinery in Midway, Kentucky, where the four-year-old will stand stud in 1996. Following a brief quarantine period, the three-time GSW in England and fastest 2,000 Guineas winner in history is scheduled to arrive at Vinery October 6.

TRAINER FRANK GOMEZ HITS 1,000 Frank Gomez, the all-time leading trainer at Calder Race Course, won his 1,000th race over the Miami oval yesterday. The conditioner of champions Princess Rooney, Smile and Cherokee Run as two-year-olds, Gomez reached the milestone when Gerda captured the day's seventh race. The son of a trainer, Gomez was born in Ireland and rode jumpers for 11 years in England, Ireland and Scotland; he came to the U.S. in 1958 and took out his trainer's license in 1967. Gomez will become the first trainer to win 100 Florida stakes races with his next added-money victory.


