MISWAKI COLT TOPS TATTERSALLS FIRST **SESSION** A bay colt by Miswaki--Bold Jessie (GB) (Never So Bold {Ire}) topped Tuesday night's first session of the Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sale at Newmarket. Consigned by Cotswold Stud, the colt, who had been previously sold as a weanling at the 1994 Keeneland November Breeding Stock sale for \$145,000, was purchased yesterday for 350,000 guineas by Addison Racing Ltd. Inc. Selling for the second highest price of 300,000 guineas was a chestnut filly by Woodman--Catopetl (Northern Dancer). Consigned by Camas Park Stud, Ireland, the filly, a half-sister to Italian Group 1 winner Close Conflict (High Estate {GB}) and stakeswinner Newton's Law (Ire) (Law Society), was purchased by Darley Stud Management Co. Ltd. Overall, 64 vearlings were sold for a total of 4,223,000 guineas and an average of 65,984 guineas. There were six horses reported as not sold. The sale concludes Thursday. ARC DE TRIOMPHE FIELD TAKES SHAPE Undefeated three-year-old Lammtarra (Nijinsky II) has been made the 7-2 early favorite for Sunday's Forte Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp by London bookmakers. Following an impressive workout on the Newmarket gallops over the weekend, English bettors are wagering on Lammtarra to become the first horse since Mill Reef in 1971 to complete the English Derby and Arc de Triomphe double. There were 27 runners--19 colts and eight fillies--left in the Arc entries at the first forfeit stage Tuesday. Trainer Andre Fabre has entered seven: last year's Arc hero Carnegie (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), Freedom Cry (GB) (Soviet Star), Swain (Ire) (Nashwan), Winged Love (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}), Housamix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), Valley of Gold (Fr) (Shirley Heights {GB}) and Muncie (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Along with Valley of Gold and Muncie, the fillies entered include last year's Irish Derby and British Oaks winner Balanchine (Storm Bird), this year's British and Irish Oaks heroine Pure Grain (GB) (Polish Precedent), French Oaks winner Carling (Fr) (Garde Royale {Ire}), Sunrise Song (Fr) (General Holme), Jural (GB) (Kris (GB)) and Olimpia Dukakis (Ity) (Isopach). The second forfeit list will be released Wednesday. Declarations to run and any supplemental entries will be announced Thursday, with final declarations set for Friday.

Blue Duster, winner of the G3 Queen Mary S. and G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot in her last two outings, maintained her unbeaten record here and in doing so, gave her trainer David Loder his first Group One success in England. The initial pace was set by DANCE SEQUENCE (Mr. Prospector), with the betting favorite Blue Duster a well-placed third. SUPAMOVA (Seattle Slew) then made a gallant effort to take the lead with three furlongs to go. With one and a half left to run, Blue Duster was asked to quicken by jockey Mick Kinane and, coming between horses, ran on in impressive style to leave the opposition standing. Kinane, who has ridden the Kentucky-bred filly to all four of her victories, said after the race, "She is very intelligent and does everything right; she had plenty left in the tank. She will be an interesting prospect next year. Blue Duster has an excellent turn of foot and covers a lot of ground." Winning trainer David Loder added, "I didn't know how she would handle the soft ground, but it didn't seem to worry her at all. She is so relaxed and has so much class that I'd be hopeful of her staying the Guineas mile next year. But we just don't know for sure and we won't until we try her next season."

ASHFORD STUD PURCHASES EAGLE EYED

Ashford Stud in Versailles, Kentucky has negotiated the purchase of the four-year-old bay colt Eagle Eyed (Danzig) from owner/breeder Khalid Abdullah, the deal being subject to contract. A full-brother to leading sire Danehill, Eagle Eved began his racing career in France, where he won over five furlongs and was second in the G3 Prix d'Arenberg as a two-vear-old. He improved on those efforts after his move to the U.S., where he won three stakes races on turf in 1994. His most important success came in the GII Arlington Classic over 1 1/8-miles and he equalled the track record for 8½-furlongs in 1:41 1/5 in the Sausalito H, at Golden Gate Fields. Eagle Eyed has won four races in 17 career starts to date for earnings of \$355,818. In his most recent outing over the Del Mar turf Aug. 6, the Bobby Frankel-trainee finished sixth in the GI Eddie Read H.

MEADOWLANDS REDUCES PURSES Purses at The Meadowlands' current Thoroughbred race meet have been reduced an average of 12 percent, effective Friday, September 29, it was announced Tuesday by Director of Racing Mike Dempsey. "We began the meet with daily purses set at an all-time Meadowlands high," Dempsey said, "but business here has been slow as it has been around the rest of the country. We hope things pick up, but the purses are a reflection of handle and we have to take this action now."

FAIR GROUNDS LOAN IN DOUBT Questions about the future of video poker in Louisiana may be tying up a \$17.5 million loan for the Fair Grounds' new grandstand and clubhouse, according to a report by the Associated Press. The loan, which the track is negotiating with First National Bank of Commerce in New Orleans, was to be backed by the track's video poker revenue, according to a measure passed by the Legislature, Louisiana's video poker industry has come under scrutiny after an FBI investigation involving alleged payoffs to legislators, and there is a growing sentiment to make the machines illegal in the state. The building, part of a major reconstruction project after a 1993 fire at the track, was scheduled to open in mid-January. Track President Bryan Krantz told the Times-Picayune Monday that the loan had hit a snag, but would not comment as to whether it involved the video poker money. Fair Grounds' 1995-96 racing season commences November 23.

LONE STAR CONSTRUCTION NEARS According to an article in yesterday's *Fort Worth Star-Telegram*, the \$55 million in bond financing for Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas should close by October 6, clearing the way for construction at the track to start the second or third week in October, according to Project Manager Bob Kaminski. Kaminski told the Grand Prairie Sports Facilities Development Corp., the city-appointed organization overseeing construction of the track, that groundbreaking on the \$110,000 million facility should take place almost immediately after the money is in the bank.
