SADLER'S WELLS IS TOPS AT TATTERSALLS

The 14-year-old stallion Sadler's Wells (Northern Dancer), Europe's leading sire, was represented by the top-priced colt as well as the four highest-priced fillies during Wednesday's second session of the 1995 Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sales in Newmarket. Overall, 108 yearlings were sold for a total of \$15,262,674 and an average of \$141,320. A pair of colts topped the session, bringing \$974,327 apiece. The first, a bay colt by Sadler's Wells out of French Group 2 winner Exclusive Order (Exclusive Native), was sold by Cheveley Park Stud to Mr. Demi O'Byrne. The colt is a half or fullbrother to six stakes performers. The second, a bay colt by Rainbow Quest--Nearctic Flame (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) from the consignment of Cheveley Park Stud, was purchased by Gainsborough Stud Management. Bringing the session's fourth highest-price of \$811,939 was a bay colt by Lear Fan--Connecting Link (Linkage), who is a half-brother to North American Grade I winner Link River (Gone West). At \$552,119, the session's highest priced filly by Sadler's Wells--Mill Princess (Ire) (Mill Reef) is a half-sister to Breeders' Cup Mile winner Last Tycoon (Ire) (Try My Best). The bay filly was consigned by Camas Park Stud, Ireland and purchased by Mr. Olin Gentry. The sale concludes today.

SHY DAWN DEAD AT 24 The 24-year-old mare Shy Dawn (*Grey Dawn II) died of an apparent heart attack at the farm of her breeder and owner, Jacques D. Wimpfheimer, it was announced yesterday. A winner of 19 races over five racing seasons, including six graded wins in New York, Shy Dawn earned \$516,301 in her career. She was the dam of eight registered foals, all of who were winners. They include Breeders' Cup Mile hero Opening Verse (The Minstrel), GIII Columbiana H. winner So She Sleeps (Seattle Slew), MSW Dangerous Dawn (Cox's Ridge) and Shy Princess (Irish River {Fr}), who was Group 1 stakes-placed in France.

Composer (Easy Goer), winner of the GII Jim Dandy at Saratoga, was scheduled to arrive at Louisiana Downs late vesterday. A winner of three of nine starts this year, Composer has earned over \$200,000 in his sophomore season. He will be ridden by Kent Desormeaux. Expected challengers include: Beavers Nose (Demons Begone), GII Arkansas Derby winner Dazzling Falls (Taylor's Falls), Gadzook (Meadowlake), GIII Southwest and GIII Rebel S. winner Mystery Storm (Storm Bird), Tenants Harbor (Badger Land), MSW Toolighttoquit (Dixieland Brass), GIII Tropical Park Derby winner Mecke (Maudlin), five-time Louisiana SW Scott's Scoundrel (L'Enioleur), Gll Pennsylvania Derby winner Pineing Patty (Country Pine), Turbulent Dancer (Gate Dancer) and Da Bull (Country Pine). The Super Derby will be televised on ESPN from 4:30-5:30 EDT.

Saturday, Bay Meadows:

BAY MEADOWS H.-GII, \$200,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/8mT The 1993 Bay Meadows H. winner Slew of Damascus (Slewacide) breezed a half-mile over the Bay Meadows turf Wednesday in :51 2/5 around the dogs. Winner of the GIII San Francisco H. on the turf in his last start Sept. 4, the seven-year-old gelding has been assigned highweight of 122 pounds for Saturday's event. Also working for the race yesterday was last year's Breeders' Cup Mile runner-up Johann Quatz (Fr) (Sadler's Wells), who drilled five furlongs in :59 4/5 handily at Santa Anita. "He's doing great; he blew out nicely," said trainer Ron McAnally. Other probable starters include GSW Silver Wizard (Silver Hawk), SW Caesour (Nureyev), MSW Caherdaniel (Tank's Prospect) and English stakes-placed Canaska Dancer (Ire) (Green Desert).

CIGAR TO WORK FOR CUP: CHALLENGERS

LINE UP Cigar (Palace Music), shooting for his 11th straight victory in the Oct. 7 Jockey Club Gold Cup, has been galloping strongly and was scheduled to work this morning at Belmont Park, according to his trainer. Bill Mott. "A race always takes something out of them, but he seems good," said Mott, who expects to work the five-year-old again next Wednesday. Despite Cigar's winning streak, the connections of several other contenders have declared their intent to challenge him. Nick Zito, trainer of Star Standard (Risen Star), second to Cigar in the Woodward, was not, however, predicting victory. "I don't know what's more impossible--getting Brooke Shields to marry me, or beating Cigar," said Zito. Nonetheless, the trainer added, "someone's got to run against him. The horse is a top three-year-old. He's like he was before the Belmont, and he ran a winning race in the Belmont, which was a two-horse race. I'm happy about that." Suburban H. winner Key Contender (Fit to Fight) has been working with jockey Angel Cordero Jr. aboard, but his rider in the Gold Cup remains uncertain. "Angel has been gettnig on him in the mornings and if it were up to me, I'd love to make history and have him ride the horse," said Carlos Martin, son and assistant to trainer Jose Martin. "It doesn't look like that will happen, though. My father and the owner will sit down next week and discuss it." Trainer Scotty Schulhofer said heis "leaning toward" running Whitney H. winner Unaccounted For (Private Account) in the Gold Cup. "We'll have to see how the field comes up and what the (Meadowlands Cup) weights are," said Schulhofer. "He's doing terrific."

HOUSTON YEARLING SALE RESULTS A chestnut filly by Zuppardo's Prince--Frank's Lil Girl brought the top bid of \$65,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Houston Preferred Yearling Sale, held Tuesday night at the Houston Polo Club. The filly, a full-sister to Astas Foxy Lady, a Grade II winner of \$335,032, was purchased by Murray Valene from consignor Clear Creek Stud, agent. A total of 73 horses were sold for a gross of \$502,600 and an average of \$6,885. Forty-six horses were reported as not sold. The sale was followed by a partial dispersal of McDermott Ranch in which 59 horses were sold for a gross of \$163,300 and an average of \$2,768.

5-1 third choice Flitch had run well in his only other career try on an off turf course, winning the GII National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame S. at Saratoga two starts back. After an unsuccessful trip to Arlington, where he finished 7th in the GI Secretariat S. Aug. 27, the Kentucky-bred colt was back in New York and back in the winner's circle, rallying from mid-pack under Mike Smith to win the Lawrence Realization by 2 3/4. "He really impressed me today," said winning trainer William Badgett. "He just ran a great race. I knew all along he was very capable of running with these horses. He proved me right." When asked what's next for Flitch, Badgett responded, "We're going to put him away for the winter. I was told win or lose that was the plan. It's been a long year and he needs the rest." Look Daggers, the only filly in the field, pressed the pace throughout and held on gamely for 2nd, while 9-5 favorite Diplomatic Jet, winner of the GIII Pilgrim S. over the soft Belmont turf at 2, had to settle for 3rd.
