### TATTERSALLS' AVERAGE SHOWS DRAMATIC

**INCREASE** Having sold the two highest-priced yearlings in Europe this year and registered significant increases across the board, Tattersalls' Chairman Edmond Mahony expressed satisfaction with the 1995 Houghton Yearling Sale at Newmarket, which concluded yesterday, "This has been a strong sale throughout and we are delighted with the way everything has gone," he said. "The support we have had from our vendors has been tremendous and has helped us to produce a genuinely world class catalogue. The standard of the catalogue has been reflected in the returns. Especially pleasing has been the depth to the market. There has been strong competition at all levels, with pinhookers, trainers, overseas buyers and, of course, the bigger battalions contributing greatly to the sale. The results from Houghton will give renewed confidence to the whole European racing and breeding scene, and provide a platform on which to build for the future." The highest price of Thursday's third and final session was paid for a bay colt by Sadler's Wells--Radiant (Foolish Pleasure). A half-brother to MGSW's Home of the Free (Hero's Honor) and Poolesta (Ire) (Hero's Honor), the colt was consigned by Camas Park Stud, Ireland, and purchased for \$893,133 by Darley Stud Management Co. Ltd. Also of note was a bay filly by Sadler's Wells out of Breeders' Cup Mile winner Royal Heroine (Ire) (Lypheor {GB}), who was sold to Mr. Demi O'Byrne, agent, for \$284,179. There were 56 yearlings sold Thursday for a gross of \$7,377,281 and an average of \$131,737. Overall during the three-day sale, 222 horses brought \$29,179,315 for an average of \$131,437, up a remarkable 33 percent from last year's average of \$98,883. Although Kahir Almaydan made the initial running, within a furlong Royal Applause had taken it up and went on to win in impressive style, not allowing any of the other runners to get near him. "This is a really good horse," said trainer Barry Hills. "He was never meant to have more than four races this year. I have just done enough to keep him going. He has such natural ability." Royal Applause is now being quoted at 16-1 for next year's 2,000 Guineas.

BREEDERS' CUP PREVIEW DAY NOTES With the main track at Belmont still drying from rain earlier in the week, trainer Bill Mott elected to postpone until Friday a scheduled breeze for early Jockey Club Gold Cup favorite Cigar (Palace Music). "I decided to wait a day," Mott said. "It doesn't matter if we work him Thursday or Friday." The \$750,000 Gold Cup is one of five Grade I stakes to be presented at Belmont during Breeders' Cup Preview Day October 7. Last year's Breeders' Cup Classic winner Concern (Broad Brush), considered a longshot to run against Cigar in the Gold Cup, breezed in Maryland yesterday. "Concern worked really well, going three-quarters in 1:13, and I'm leaning toward sending him in the Meadowlands Cup (Oct. 6), said trainer Richard Small. Three four-year-old fillies took to the track at Belmont vesterday to prepare for their matchups with champion Heavenly Prize (Seeking the Gold) in the GI Beldame S. Little Buckles (Buckley Boy), third to Heavenly Prize in the GI Go For Wand S. at Saratoga July 23, drilled five furlongs in :58.28. "She's doing real good," said trainer John DeStefano. "Realistically, it would be a shocker to beat Heavenly Prize but if we can be second, that's good money." Cinnamon Sugar (Ire) (Wild Again) covered the same distance in :59.39, and possible starter Dancing With Deb (Cox's Ridge) breezed a half-mile in :48.83. Arlington Million hero Awad (Caveat) will make his first start since that Aug. 27 victory in the GI Turf Classic Invitational, also on Breeders' Cup Preview Day. The five-year-old is scheduled to work over the Belmont turf today. "Nobody will work too fast because the turf is so soft," said trainer David Donk. Announced Thursday as a definite starter in the Turf Classic was French-based Hernando (Fr) (Niniski). Winner of the G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron at Deauville for the second straight year two starts back, five-year-old Hernando, sixth in last year's Breeders' Cup Turf after finishing a close second in the Arc de Triomphe, is expected to arrive in New York Sunday.

### FIRST STAKES WINNER FOR BLACK TIE

AFFAIR Blacktie Bid (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) became the first stakes winner for her freshman sire with a 11/2length win in Wednesday night's \$49,500 Black Swan S. at Fairplex Park. The two-year-old filly, who covered the 1 1/16-miles in 1:46 4/5, was earning her second win in four starts. Nine-year-old Black Tie Affair, who earned \$3,370,694 and was voted 1991 Horse of the Year and Champion Older Horse after capping off his year with a win in the Breeders' Cup Classic, stands at Vinery in Midway, Kentucky. He has been represented by 11 winners from his first crop for earnings of \$248,862 to date.


