DUE PROCESS TO DISPERSE John Perrotta, General Manager of Robert Brennan's Due Process Stable, yesterday announced plans for three-stage dispersal of the stable's racing and breeding stock. The announcement came on the heels of a report in Friday's *Asbury Park (NJ) Press* that a newly unsealed 13-count civil racketeering lawsuit against Brennan and eight others includes charges that Brennan used a series of "sham" transactions to gain secret control of two brokerage firms. The Press reported that the state of New Jersey is charging that Brennan masterminded a "sophisticated" conspiracy that earned him more than \$123 million in profits the past seven years. This past June, a federal court found that Brennan and his First Jersey Securities had conducted a "massive and continuing fraud" on the firm's investors, and Brennan was ordered to pay \$75 million to the federal Securities and Exchange Commission. The Due Process racehorses will be sold at the Fasig-Tipton Horses of Racing Age Sale to be held at Belmont Park Nov. 21. Breeding stock, including **Sister Dot**, the dam of champion two-year-old **Dehere** (Deputy Minister), and her 1995 Danzig filly, will be auctioned at the Keeneland January sale. Yearlings will be sold at the Fasig-Tipton Two-Year-Olds-in-Training Sale Feb. 26-27 at Calder. "Current conditions dictate that we undergo a reorganization and restructuring at this time," said Perrotta. "Mr. Brennan remains a staunch supporter of the sport and the biggest racing fan I know."

ILLINOIS TRACK OWNERS MEET WITH GOVERNOR Owners of Arlington International Racecourse, Sportsman's Park and Hawthorne Race Course held a 90-minute meeting with Illinois Governor Jim Edgar Thursday in an attempt to resolve their dispute over 1996 Thoroughbred dates. The track owners declined to comment but the Governor called the meeting "very productive" and said "they have agreed to continue discussions to work on changes that could keep the racing industry vital in Illinois." Sources say one of the proposals on the table calls for Sportsman's and Hawthorne to lease Arlington and run their Thoroughbred meetings there. Christine Janks, president of the Chicago Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association, said she favors this consolidation.

Undefeated **Lammtarra** (Nijinsky II), winner of his lone start at two, came back to take the Epsom Derby and the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. this year and is the 7-2 early favorite to keep his record unblemished with a win in the Arc. Last year's Arc victor **Carnegie (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) is 5-1 third choice to take his second straight; the four-year-old is seven-for-11 lifetime and two-for-two in France this year. His jockey, Thierry Jarnet, has won this race in two of the last three years, aboard *Subotica* in 1992 and with this runner last year.

GOFFS ARC SALE PREVIEW Goffs France will hold its 1995 Vente de l'Arc Sale of Horses of Racing Age at Saint-Cloud today. There are 77 horses of various ages, including nine yearlings and a weanling, scheduled to pass through the ring beginning at 6:30 p.m. local time. The leading consigner by number of horses catalogued is Mme. Christiane Head, with 14. Among the offerings are the three-year-old colt **Two o' Clock Jump (Ire)** (Be My Guest), winner of the G3 Prix Quincey at Deauville in his last start Aug. 26, and the five-year-old horse **Pinot (Ger)** (Nebos {Ger}), a Group 2 winner in Germany and Group 3 winner in France.

CIGAR PREPS FOR GOLD CUP; AWAD ON TRACK FOR TURF CLASSIC Appearing on the work tab for the first time since his victory in the GI Woodward, **Cigar** (Palace Music) went six furlongs in 1:15.88 over the Belmont main track yesterday; the five-year-old will make his next start in the Jockey Club Gold Cup on Breeders' Cup Preview Day, October 7. "It was exactly what I was expecting," said trainer Bill Mott of the breeze. "I think he's doing just fine. I'm pleased with the way he's been doing. I'll blow him out a couple of days before the race." Added Cigar's regular exercise rider, Fonda Albertrani, "He just bounced right along. He seemed to be his usual self. He didn't even turn a hair--it was like a gallop for him. He galloped out and then cooled out perfect." Also working yesterday, Arlington Million winner **Awad** (Caveat) went a mile on the Belmont dirt. New York Racing Association clockers caught the grass specialist going six furlongs in 1:14.63, breezing; he will go next in the Turf Classic on the Breeders' Cup Preview card. "He went in company and it was a nice blowout for him," said trainer Dave Donk. "He caught his breath pretty quick. I'm pleased with him, and we seem to be right on target. If I get to work on the grass with him next Thursday, I'll blow him out three-eighths."

CORDERO RETURN AVAILABLE VIA SATELLITE Jockey Angel Cordero Jr.'s return to race riding will be broadcast via satellite Sunday. Cordero will ride **Bandit Bomber** (Prosperous) in the fourth race at El Comandante, and **Precious Heredity** (Big Mukora) in Sunday's seventh race at the Puerto Rican oval; post times for the two events are 4:15 p.m. EDT and 5:30 p.m. EDT, respectively. The signal will be offered free on Spacenet 2, Transponder 7. Cordero has announced that he will donate half of his earnings from the day's mounts to the residents of Vieques and Culebra, two Puerto Rican towns damaged by Hurricane Marilyn.
