MILLKOM RETIRED According to a report in to-day's *Daily Racing Form*, Millkom (GB) (Cyrano de Bergerac) has been retired and will stand at stud next season. The four-year-old, rated the highweight three-year-old at nine-and-a-half to 11 furlongs in France last year, won 10 in a row over the course of two seasons before finishing ninth in last year's Arc de Triomphe. A winner once in three starts in France this year, the English-bred shipped to the U.S. for what would be the final start of his career, posting an eye-catching victory in the GI Man o'War S. at Belmont September 16. He came out of the race with a bowed right front tendon. Owner Gary Tanaka, who purchased Millkom just three weeks before the Man o'War, has not made a decision as to where the colt will go to stud.

PERRET POSTS 4,000TH WIN Jockey Craig Perret notched his 4,000th career victory at Turfway Park yesterday, booting home Heloise (Forty Niner) to win the eighth race by three-quarters of a length. The 44-year-old Louisiana native, who has won the Kentucky Derby, Belmont Stakes and three Breeders' Cup races, said of this accomplishment, "I'm just glad I achieved this in Kentucky, since this is my home now. I've got a farm in Florida, and I was flying home every Sunday night for years--that was getting a little tough, so we decided to buy a farm right here."

EUROPEAN INVADERS HEADED TO TURF

CLASSIC A trio of European runners will ship into Belmont Park this week to prepare for next Saturday's GI Turf Classic at a mile and a half. Leading the contingent is Hernando (Fr) (Niniski), second in last year's Arc de Triomphe and France's 1994 highweight older horse at 11 to 14 furlongs. The five-year-old has one win in three starts this year, taking a Group 3 race at Deauville in August; he is scheduled to arrive in New York late this evening. Accompanying Hernando on the flight will be the filly Privity (Private Account), who will also try the Turf Classic. The three-year-old, a Group 2 winner in France this year, has two wins in eight career starts. Set to fly in Wednesday is Rifapour (Ire) (Shahrastani); the three-year-old colt has won half his six lifetime starts, including the Group 2 Prix Hocquart in May. News cont. p2

A near miss in the GI Secretariat S. last out pretty well summed up Mecke's year until this point; always the bridesmaid, rarely the bride. Stakes-placed in six events this year, two of them graded, and fifth in both the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, he had consistently faced the top three-year-olds in the country while winning just one of 11 starts on the season--the Tropical Park Derby in his '95 debut. Still, the crowd sent him off the 2-1 choice and suffered through an anxious moment when he stumbled slightly at the start. Settling off the pace, he came five-wide into the stretch and rocketed through the lane to win going away. "We've had a lot of bad luck this year and it had to turn around sooner or later," said trainer Manny Tortora. "He has run hard this year, and he finally won the big one." Tortora said plans for his next start were indefinite, while owner James Lewis Jr. confirmed that Mecke would not be supplemented to the Breeders' Cup Classic.

DOUBLE TRIGGER (IRE) (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}) set the pace, but was taken on by Moonax early in the straight, and after Moonax seemed to control the race, Always Earnest came from the rear to challenge from the wide outside, snatching victory in the last strides. There was a stewards' enquiry after the head-on film showed the two leaders had bumped inside the final furlong, but the result was allowed to stand, giving the winner's dam, Nettie Cometti, her second graded stakes winner in less than a day (see East Report, p4). "This horse was making a comeback as he had not run since May," said owner/trainer Miriam Bollack-Badel. "I thought the pace was too slow, but he produced a great effort." Double Trigger, winner of the Ascot Gold Cup, Goodwood Cup and Doncaster Cup, appeared not to stay the distance on the very soft ground; his challenge for the Melbourne Cup in Australia in November is now open to doubt.

I think the logical choice right now will be the Queen Elizabeth II (Oct. 21 at Keeneland)."
