ANOTHER TRIUMPH: LAMMTARRA

TAKES ARC Sweeping though his fourth victory in just four lifetime starts, undefeated Lammtarra (*Nijinsky II) stalked frontrunning Luso (GB) (Salse) to the final turn in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, then powered to the lead and held off a strong late bid from Freedom Crv (GB) (Soviet Star) to post a threequarter length score at Longchamp vesterday. Luso faded to 13th. It was a wonderfully game victory for Lammtarra, who becomes the first horse since Mill Reef in 1971 to win the Epsom Derby, King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. and the Arc in the same season. Said winning rider Frankie Dettori, 24, "This horse is a lion, a fighter. He's so tough, so hard. He doesn't want to lose. He always wants to win. I adopted different tactics with him this time. He's still immature and I wanted to keep him up with the pace. He's a real champion racehorse. He would have won by three lengths in another 50 yards. This is the best dream of my life." Lammtarra becomes the first British Arc winner since Carroll House in 1989, and gives Dettori, champion jockey in England last year, his first Arc victory. The three-year-old may ship across the Atlantic for what could be the final start in his short but brilliant career. "It is up to Sheikh Mohammed (the owner's father, oldest of the four Maktoum brothers and ruler of Dubai) where the horse will run next, but he may possibly go for the Breeders' Cup Turf," said Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum, adding. "It is almost certain that he will be retired to stud at the end of the season and, if he stays in Britain, he will stand at Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket. If he retires to the U.S.A., he will go to Gainsborough Farm in Kentucky."

CORDERO RIDES AGAIN In a dramatic and emotional return to riding, Angel Cordero Jr. made it back to the track and to the winner's circle vesterday at El Commandante Racetrack in his native Puerto Rico. Cordero, 52, had not ridden a race since January 12. 1992, when he was involved in a near-fatal spill at Aqueduct. Victory came aboard Puerto Rican champion Bandit Bomber (Prosperous), who won a seven-furlong allowance race by 12 1/4 lengths, posting his 29th victory in 31 career starts. Adding to the excitement. the 1-20 favorite completed the distance in 1:21 2/5. breaking the track record set by Mr. Frisky in 1990. "This horse is so good, he can carry me at my age and win," said Cordero. "If he had lost, the only excuse would have been that the jockey was too old." Cordero added that his comeback was not without mixed emotions. "I felt a lot of pressure, more than I thought I would," he said. "I now realize that I have lost the love I always had for riding, which is very sad. It was something that I loved so much, and that's gone." Cordero, who finished second in a photo aboard Precious Heredity (Big Mukora), his only other mount on the day, said he still hopes to participate in the Breeders' Cup October 28, and that he would like to ride once or twice more before the big event. Bandit Bomber will ship to New York for the October 27 Sport Page H., but it has not been announced who will be in the saddle for that start.

FIRST STAKES WINNER FOR ACADEMY

AWARD Freshman sire **Academy Award** (Secretariat), a graded stakes winner of \$226,943, had his first stakes winner Saturday when Winning Actress captured the \$120,050 Illinois Breeders' Debutante S. at Hawthorne. 
