BREEDERS' CUP DRESS REHEARSAL AT

**BELMONT** Some of the stars hit the mark flawlessly, others needed the chance to run their lines, but if vesterday's Breeders' Cup Preview Day at Belmont Park was just the rehearsal then racing fans are in for a really big show October 28. Cigar (Palace Music), once again the headliner, performed as he has done his last 10 starts, stalking the pace to the turn, slipping past frontrunning Star Standard (Risen Star) on the outside as the three-year-old drifted wide past the middle of the track, then drawing clear while kept to the task by iockey Jerry Bailey. "He really didn't get hold of the track...but he won in spite of it," said Bailey. But the usually ultra-consistent Thunder Gulch (Gulch) seemed to tire after pressing the pace and faded to fifth. "He just didn't have it today," said his jockey, Gary Stevens. Team Lukas' Hennessy (Storm Cat), the division leader coming into the Moet Champagne, lost his lofty position in his first start since the GI Hopeful. The two-year-old loomed boldly at the top of the lane, but he also lacked a closing punch, weakening to finish sixth as GI Futurity winner Maria's Mon (Wavering Monarch) swept to the lead and to the head of the class. But the distaff division of the Lukas stable did not let the team down; both Golden Attraction (Mr. Prospector) and Serena's Song (Rahy) led their fields from start to finish to take the Frizette and Beldame, respectively. Said Lukas of his two-year-old filly, "She ran a picture-perfect race. She went to the front and we never looked back; that was our plan. This filly is about as good as any other filly I've had in the past." Which would include certain Eclipse winner Serena's Song, who outfinished 3-5 Heavenly Prize (Seeking the Gold) for a 3/4-length score. "You have to credit Serena's Song with running a race that was nothing short of spectacular," said Lukas. "She's hickory tough and she thrives on activity." The only real upset in the day's five Grade I events was 17-1 Turk Passer's (Turkoman) wire-to-wire win in the Turf Classic. The 6-5 favorite, Awad (Caveat), winner of the GI Arlington Million, raced much closer to the pace than is his style but had nothing left for the finish and ended up seventh. "He was a bit keen early and he wasn't able to get the covered-up trip I would have liked," said trainer Dave Donk. "I'm a bit disappointed, but maybe he needed the race." The also rans will get a second chance in the Breeders' Cup in three weeks time, but that day there are no excuses. News cont. p2

Star Standard went right for the early lead, while Cigar and THUNDER GULCH (Gulch) were content to sit back off the early pace. Nearing the far turn, the two favorites moved as a team in their assault on the leader, but as Cigar drew alongside Star Standard on the turn and was carried seven-wide by the pacesetter, Thunder Gulch began to steadily drop back. Cigar took the lead near the top of the stretch, was struck once with the whip in midstretch and won under a hand ride thereafter, withstanding the late challenge of Unaccounted For. "I just have to say that every time I open my mouth, he goes out and proves he's as good as I say he is," said winning trainer Bill Mott." The runner-up, coming off a six-week break, made the winner work for it and finished well to be second. He will be back for another shot at the champ in the Classic, as will Thunder Gulch. "I called on him at the half-mile pole and he just wasn't there," said his jockey, Gary Stevens. "I think that the way he came back, he was physically and not mentally tired," Added trainer D. Wayne Lukas, "I'm not making any excuses, I think we were beat by a very nice horse. We'll just see what happens on the 28th."

"He's a horse on the rise and he's getting better and better," said his trainer, Nick Zito. HENNESSY (Storm Cat), favored at even-money, was making his first start since his Hopeful win August 27; the bright chestnut made his move along the rail at the top of the lane but hung late. The second-longest shot on the board after going winless since April, Turk Passer showed an affinity for the soft turf and the slow pace, leading the field from flagfall to finish and leaving enough in the tank to hold off European invader Hernando, "He wasn't supposed to like the soft going--it was only this morning that we actually decided to go ahead and run," said trainer Scotty Schulhofer, who took over the turf runner's training at the beginning of the Saratoga meet. "The owners were the ones that really wanted to run, so I have to thank them." Schulhofer added that the Breeders' Cup Turf or the Knickerbocker H. the day before would be next for the Florida-bred. The second finisher, whose last two wins have been in the '94 and '95 G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron, ran on well despite preferring a firmer turf. "He ran a lovely race but the ground was awfully soft for me," said jockey Cash Asmussen, "If my horse comes back good, I'd look for him to benefit and be alright next time out, hopefully in the Breeders' Cup Turf."

On the turn, she spurted clear by four, and while her lead diminished to 3/4 at the wire, she was never seriously threatened by her closest challenger. The 3-5 favorite, Heavenly Prize, rated off the winner's pace early, dropped back to fourth running down the backside and closed gamely through the stretch. "Even though she ran second, I still think she ran a great race," said Shug McGaughey, Heavenly Prize's trainer. "Serena's Song got on the lead early and with the slow fractions, I knew it was going to be hard to catch her." McGaughey, who had discussed the possibility of sending his filly to the Breeders' Cup Classic, said plans for her next start were uncertain.



Top Account won three straight this summer, including the GII King's Bishop at Saratoga, before falling victim to French Deputy in the Sept. 4 Jerome at Belmont. Off the board in the Vosburgh last out after breaking slowly, he did so again today but began his last-to-first move on the turn to win going away. The 1-5 favorite, French Deputy, did not care for the going, according to jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. "He had trouble gripping it," said his rider. "I had ridden him (three times) and I knew right away there was something wrong today." Said trainer Neil Drysdale, "I don't know what I'm going to do with him next. I have to look him over and decide if I'll send him to the Breeders' Cup Classic."
