BAHRI HEADS CHAMPION FIELD Britain's bookmakers have installed **Bahri** (Riverman) 9-4 favourite for Saturday's Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket. But owner Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum, wary of the weather and still with one eye on the Breeders' Cup Mile, will not confirm the colt as a definite runner until the end of the week. Soft ground would almost certainly count him out of the Group 1 event. Epsom Derby second **Tamure** (Sadler's Wells) is, however, is an intended starter, as is **Spectrum** (Rainbow Quest); **Germany** (Trempolino) and **Riyadian** (Polish Precedent) have been supplemented to the race at a cost of \$270,646 each.

HANDLE UP AT LOUISIANA DOWNS Louisiana Downs completed its 22nd season Sunday with a 13.1 percent increase in total handle. Wagering on-track and through the simulcast network totalled \$192,137,935; last year's total handle was \$169,851,941. The all-time leading rider at the track, Ronald Ardoin, won his fifth title with 165 wins, including his 4,000th career victory aboard I'm A Legion July 3. Jim Gaston won his second local training title, saddling 74 winners for a 20 percent win average. Four-time Eclipse Award winning owner John Franks, who has led the standings at Louisiana Downs since 1982, was once again the top owner.

Alywow (Alysheba), last year's Horse of the Year and champion grass horse in Canada and second in this race in '94, worked seven furlongs in 1:29 on the soft grass at Woodbine yesterday, galloping out the mile in 1:45 2/5. The filly has run twice since undergoing surgery to repair a hairline fracture to her right hind cannon bone suffered in the GI Matriarch S. last November; she was second in a mile allowance race August 26, then came back two weeks later to take the runner-up spot in the Jockey Club Cup H. at a mile and three-eighths. "She could be sitting on top of a big race," said her trainer, Roger Attfield. Charlie's Dewan (Charlie Barley), winner of the 12-furlong Breeders' S. and the nine-furlong Halton S, in his last two outings, both on turf, also breezed yesterday, going three-quarters in 1:16. "Chuckie went along good," said trainer and co-owner Mark Frostad. "He didn't mind the soft going at all." Jet Freighter (Cozzene), winner of the Jockey Club Cup, went five-eighths in 1:02 1/5, breezing, on Monday's Woodbine work tab. "The horse is coming up to the race perfect," said Dr. Don Fishman, stable manager for the four-year-old's owners, Fishman's son Uri and Hong Kong businessman Peter Yu. Talloires (Trempolino), runner-up in the Gran Premio Brasil, breezed six furlongs at Santa Anita Monday and was scheduled to ship to Canada last night.
